## **Committee Updates**

**LAEOP** – Upcoming winter meeting in a couple of weeks per Denise Lee. Jerry's Nut House will be done next fall. LAEP has a small membership. They would like to increase membership.

**Insurance** – Jessica Talen and Lisa Thursby - Gave us the first round of offers from both carriers. Mercer was going to go back.

Next meeting is at the end of January. Carriers take a look at the usage for our plans. Ken stated they look at what they need to make a profile. Got some initial quotes came back in December. Impact of rates will include the elimination of the Affordable Care Act. Right now there shouldn't be substantial changes for this year.

#### **Nutrition Services**

Brenda Rodriguez and Sarah Kinney have been hired to be supervisors for Nutrition Services. They will divide the schools, so each will work with elementary, middle and high schools.

Littleton Public school services: 800 Breakfast per day - 138,000 annually with 80% free & reduce 4,000 lunches per day - 690,000 annually with 40-50% free & reduce

Summer program feed from 40 students to 250 students. SACC programs use this program a lot.



# **Operations, Maintenance and Custodial**

A daytime and nighttime Custodial Foreman has been hired for each building. The Foreman will be trained so there can be consistency in the schools. This will make it more efficient for all of the custodial staff including substitutes.

Littleton Public Schools has 100 custodians throughout the district. The department has hired some of our Transition student to fill some of the positions. They have also started hiring high school student to fill the substitute positions.
