It is one of the popular tourist attractions of the region. The area is packed with wooden windmills, barns, houses and museums and built in the typically Dutch wooden architectural style.</p> <p>You will enjoy a boat tour on the Zaan river: from the waterside you will see still the old factories and mills.</p> <p>After lunch (at own expense) we will visit the Anne Frank House, the place where Anne and her family hid during WW II. The Hague is also known as the 'Royal City by the Sea' and is called 'the residence city' because of the many members of the Dutch Royal Family who reside in its chic neighborhoods.</p> <p>Upon arrival meet your guides for a tour of the city</p> <p>Lunch (at own expense)</p> <p>Performance at "The New Church"</p> <p>The New Church was built in 1656 and is one of the oldest monuments in the city centre. <p>Day 5</p> <p>Monday March 20, 2017</p>	<p>Breakfast at the hotel followed by check out</p> <p>Today we will enter the country of Belgium</p> <p>Drive to Brussels (<i>approximately 2 hours driving time</i>)</p> <p>Upon arrival in Brussels meet your local guides and enjoy a guided city tour of Brussels – not only the capital of Belgium but also of the European Union. Often described as Europe's most impressive town square, the Grand Place, with its ornate Flemish architecture is the central hub of Brussels.</p> <p>Lunch (at own expense)</p> <p>The city is filled with museums, ornate buildings and also modern attractions such as the Atomium and mini-Europe. See the Mannekin Pis, famous as a symbol of Brussels.</p> <p>In the afternoon we will visit to the Musical Instrument Museum of Brussels. This fascinating museum houses a unique collection of musical instruments.</p> <p>Visit the Cathedral of St Michael. Often described as Europe's most impressive town square, the Grand Place, with its ornate Flemish architecture is the central hub of Brussels.</p> <p>Afterwards explore the centre of Brussels on foot (in small Chaperone groups). <p>Day 6</p> <p>Tuesday March 21, 2017</p>	<p>Breakfast at the hotel followed by Check out.</p> <p>Meet your coaches and depart for Bruges.</p> <p>On arrival meet your guides and enjoy a sightseeing tour of this beautiful medieval canal city. Best explored on foot you will see explore the Markt Square, a lively centre of the city and its medieval commerical centre. Climb the Belfry, the city's most famous landmark – towering 263 feet above the square there are 366 steps to the top. The clock strikes every 15 minutes and 47 bells sound.</p> <p>Burg Square is the city's other main square and is the historical centre of Bruges. See the Stadhuis, the Court of Justice and the Basilica of the Holy Blood.</p> <p>Later this morning enjoy a visit to the Chocolate Museum. The city's famous Cologne Cathedral (<i>Kölner Dom</i>) is the seat of the Catholic Archbishop of Cologne.
