Location: Castle Rock Middle School 2575 Meadows Blvd, Castle Rock, CO 80109

Date: Saturday December 2, 2017

Format: 4 Round Swiss G/30 Unrated (No elimination, all players play every round)

Divisions: K-2, 3-5, 6-8, 9-12 (Divisions may be combined at the discretion of the tournament director)

Price: \$15.00 if post marked by Friday November 3, 2017 and \$20.00 if post marked after Friday November 3, 2017. Registration will end on Wednesday November 29, 2017. No onsite registration.

Registration Discounts: We are offering a \$1.00 discount for bringing a vinyl chess set and \$1.00 discount for bringing a chess clock. One chess set and one clock discount limit per individual player. Be sure to label your clock and chess set, as the Blue Knights Chess Club will not be tracking your personal items.

Chess Notation: Divisions 6-8 & 9-12 will be required to turn in notated chess games to the Tournament Director to verify win, loss, draw. Divisions K-2 & 3-5 are not required to notate chess games but are encouraged to do so. 6-8 & 9-12 divisions are required to provide their own notation sheets and pencils.

Concessions: Food and drinks will be available for purchase throughout the entire event.

Supervision & Behavior Waiver: A great measure of a successful scholastic chess tournament is the behavior of players and the adults that are responsible for supervising them. All players must be accompanied by an adult who is 18 years of age or older during the entire tournament—parent, guardian, or school coach. Players that are not supervised will be disqualified from the tournament and asked to leave Castle Rock Middle School premises without refund. Parents, guardians, and coaches are not allowed in the playing area during official game play. Adults will receive one warning upon violation of this expectation; the second infraction you and your player/child will be disqualified

from the tournament and asked to leave Castle Rock Middle School premises immediately without refund. Players will receive one warning upon disruptive behavior; the second infraction will result in immediate disqualification from the event and asked to leave Castle Rock Middle School premises without refund. The tournament director will have final say in these decisions. Bottom line—lets be safe, respectful, and have FUN!!!
