PARENT VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

LUNCH

- Lunches from home or lunch purchased from the cafeteria (Lunch may be eaten outside on the school grounds if accompanied by a parent.)
- PLEASE PLAN AHEAD: Students may choose to go out to lunch with an adult chaperone, but must notify their classroom teacher in writing by that morning.
- After lunch, students check in at their first station on the field with their teacher.
