EXCUSING YOUR STUDENT FOR AN APPOINTMENT: If your student has an appointment that will cause him/her to miss class time, the following procedure should be followed:

- 1. Phone the appointment information into the Attendance Office at (303) 734-6700 at least 24 hours in advance. Include the time your student needs to leave and the time you expect him/her to return to school.
- 2. A pass will be prepared and waiting in the Attendance Office for your student to pick up before school on the day of the appointment.
 - a. Your student needs to give the pass to the appropriate teacher before class begins so he/she can leave class with minimal interruption.
 - b. If your student is leaving between classes, no pass is necessary. You will just need to call and excuse him/her from any periods missed.
- 3. Upon returning to school your student must check in at the Attendance Office, even if it is during an unscheduled or passing period. Failure to do so may result in an unexcused absence.

Please note: If a message is left on the recorder the day of the appointment, it may not be retrieved until after your student needs to leave. If you arrive at school to pick up your student without prior notice, you may experience a delay that could cause you to be late for your appointment as we do not always have someone available to run passes to classrooms.

STUDENT FEES: Second semester course fees, AP exam balances, and winter athletic participation fees have been posted to student accounts in Infinite Campus. Payment is due by February 28, 2018. There are two ways to pay fees:

- Pay Online You may pay online through RevTrak on the homepage of the Heritage website: <u>http://littletonpublicschools.net/schools/heritage-high-school/making-payments</u>. You will need your Campus Portal parent username and your student's date of birth to pay fees online.
- Send a Check If you are paying by check, please include your student's name or ID number and mail to Heritage High School, Attn: Bookkeeper, 1401 West Geddes Avenue, Littleton, CO 80120, or your student may drop a check or cash by the bookkeeping window.

For Seniors:

• All outstanding fees and fines must be paid to receive their cap and gown and participate in the graduation ceremony.

For All Students:

- Must have a balance less than \$100 to attend prom.
- Must pay all outstanding fees and fines to pick up your yearbook.
- If students have a book fine on their accounts, the book(s) need to be returned to the bookkeeper and the fine will be removed, minus a late charge.
- Deadline to buy a yearbook is February 20, 2018.

safeTALK is a three and a half hour program designed by Living-Works Education. It helps prepare participants to identify and connect persons with thoughts of suicide to suicide first aid resources. Most people with thoughts of suicide invite help in some way. Alert helpers learn how to identify those invitations and connect that person with someone who can help keep them safe from suicide.

safeTALK helps you:

- Avoid missing, dismissing or avoiding suicide;
- Identify people who have thoughts of suicide;
- Apply the safeTALK steps (Tell, Ask, Listen and KeepSafe)

Powerful video clips illustrate the safeTALK process. Discussion and practice help stimulate learning.

safeTALK is not designed for those who have experienced a recent loss of a loved one to suicide.
