Dear Parents/Guardians of High School Students:

Our teachers design their curriculum and lesson plans to meet the learning expectations outlined in the *Colorado Academic Standards (CAS)* which are the expectations for what students need to learn and be able to demonstrate at the end of each grade. These standards reflect the critical-thinking, problem solving, effective communication skills, as well as critical content students need to be truly prepared for success after high school in the 21st century.

Good instruction based on standards and assessments of student learning cannot occur in isolation of one another; together they guide measurable student learning and achievement. Using quality next-generation assessments allows us to measure students' knowledge of these expectations, monitor their growth towards learning goals, and ensure they are on-track to be college & career ready by the time students graduate.

Beginning April 3rd, students across Colorado will take the *Colorado Measures of Academic Success (CMAS)*. In grade nine, students will take the English Language Arts and Mathematics assessments which measure student knowledge of these content standards. In grade eleven, students will also be assessed in the science *Colorado Academic Standards*.

These statewide assessments are considered an assessment of all students and are a part of our school accreditation and federal requirements. Make-up tests will be needed for those absent; therefore, we request that you please try to avoid medical/dental and other appointments during testing times. Nuestros maestros diseñan su currículum y sus lecciones para cumplir las expectativas definidas en los Estándares Académicos de Colorado (en inglés, *Colorado Academic Standards – CAS*) que son las expectativas de lo que los estudiantes deben aprender y ser capaces de demostrar al final de cada grado. Estos estándares reflejan las habilidades del pensamiento crítico, la resolución de problemas y la comunicación efectiva, así como el contenido crítico que los estudiantes necesitan para estar verdaderamente preparados para tener éxito después de la escuela preparatoria en el siglo XXI.

Una buena enseñanza basada en los estándares y en las evaluaciones del aprendizaje del estudiante no puede darse por separado los unos de las otras; juntos guían el aprendizaje y los logros mensurables del estudiante. Usar evaluaciones de calidad y de nueva generación nos permite medir el conocimiento que los estudiantes poseen de estas expectativas, monitorear su crecimiento en relación con los objetivos de aprendizaje, y asegurarnos de que se encuentran en el buen camino para estar listos para la universidad o para un oficio cuando se gradúen los estudiantes.

A partir del 3 de abril, los estudiantes de Colorado tomarán los exámenes Medidas de Éxito Académico (en inglés, *Colorado Measures of Academic Success - CMAS*). En noveno grado, los estudiantes tomarán los exámenes de Lengua y Matemáticas para medir el conocimiento de los estudiantes del contenido de estos estándares. En el grado 11, los estudiantes tomarán también el examen de Ciencias del *Colorado Academic Standards*.

Estas evaluaciones a lo largo del estado se consideran una evaluación de todos los estudiantes, son parte del proceso de acreditación de nuestras escuelas y son requisitos federales. Se realizarán exámenes extraordinarios para aquellos estudiantes que estén ausentes durante los días normales de los exámenes; por lo tanto, les rogamos que, por favor, intenten evitar hacer citas médicas, en el dentista u otras citas durante las fechas de estos exámenes.
