ATTENTION SENIORS: Please come into the Post Grad Center and complete your graduation survey. We want to know what your plans are for after graduation. This survey takes about three minutes and determines where your final transcripts will go after graduation. If this survey is not completed you will not be able to pick up your cap and gown. Also, please bring in any scholarship information.

PE LOCKS ARE DUE: All students are reminded to turn in their P.E. locks on Thursday, May 11, or Friday, May 12, depending on which day your class meets. Locks must be turned in or a \$10 fine will be assessed. Students with unpaid lock fines will not be able to purchase parking permits in the fall, and seniors will not be able to pick up their caps and gowns for graduation.

STUDENT FEES/FINES AND END OF YEAR TEXTBOOK RETURN:

- TEXTBOOKS are due on dates specified by individual teachers. A \$5 late fee is assessed if books are not returned during the class period specified by the teacher. **Late books** must be returned to the Bookkeeper's Office (not to the teacher) to ensure proper credit to the student's account.
- PROM tickets are on sale now. Juniors and seniors need to have a balance of less than \$100 to purchase prom tickets.
- YEARBOOKS will be distributed Monday, May 15. All students need to have a \$0.00 balance to pick up their yearbooks.
- CAP AND GOWN pick up is Friday, May 19, at 1:00 pm. Seniors need to have all textbooks turned in and all fees/fines paid by the end of the day on Thursday, May 18.
- PARKING PERMITS - students must have all books returned and fees/fines paid to purchase a parking permit in August.

END OF YEAR CHROMEBOOK COLLECTION: If you have a school-issued Chromebook, you must check it back in before the end of the school year. Chromebooks will be checked in during your Advisory class. Senior Chromebooks will be collected Monday, May 15, during Advisory. All other students' Chromebooks will be collected on Monday, May 22, during Advisory. Please remember to bring your **Chromebook and charger** on the day of your check in. Your Chromebooks will be kept with your Advisory group so you will receive the same device back in the fall. Chromebooks that are not checked-in will be assessed a \$185 lost Chromebook fine per the 1:1 Chromebook Responsible Use Policy.

LIBRARY NEWS: The last fee reminders for the library this school year will be handed out in Advisory classes on Monday, May 8. If you have fees of more than \$5, you must pay the bookkeeper and/or bring the overdue book or Chromebook to her in good condition in order for the replacement cost to be reduced to a late fee. Fees of less than \$5 should be paid in the library. Please clear up any fines ASAP so we can update your account.

LOCKER CLEANOUT: On Monday, May 15, seniors will clean out their lockers during Advisory. Then on Monday, May 22, all other students will clean out their lockers during Advisory. Anything left in lockers after school on Friday, May 26, will be donated to charity. Because Heritage will be closed for construction this summer, all lost and found items will have to be donated immediately after school on May 26.

Two-credit classes may take finals on Thursday, May 18, during class. If more time is needed, teachers may opt to begin two-credit class exams on Tuesday, May 16 and finish the final on Thursday, May 18. Teachers will be available to assist students requesting additional help in the afternoon on Tuesday and Thursday after finals. Per Heritage School Policy and in order to maintain the integrity of final examinations, there will be no early final exams given. Students not present to take an exam when scheduled, will receive a "0" (zero) for their final exam score and have two weeks from the end of second semester in which to complete a make-up exam. Therefore, all finals must be made-up by Thursday, June 15. Once a student has made up an exam and his/her teacher has graded the exam, his/her teacher will replace the "0" (zero) with the score earned on the final exam and will submit a grade change form in the fall so that the appropriate grade change can be made on official transcripts. If a student fails to make-up his/her exam during the allotted two week time frame, his/her semester exam score will remain a "0" and the semester grade will remain unchanged.

Due to Heritage being closed for Bond Work this summer, students will be making up missed final exams at Powell Middle School in the Library/Media Center. Students must check the Heritage summer office hours which are posted on the [Summer Information page of the HHS web site](#). In order to assure that someone will be at Powell to administer a makeup exam, students need to schedule an appointment with the Heritage Counseling Office at 303-347-7610.
