END OF YEAR CHROMEBOOK COLLECTION: If you have a school-issued Chromebook, you must check it back in before the end of the school year. Chromebooks will be checked-in during your Advisory class. Senior Chromebooks will be collected on Monday, May 15. All other students' Chromebooks will be collected on Monday, May 22. Please remember to bring your Chromebook and charger on the day of your check in. Your Chromebooks will be kept with your Advisory group so you will receive the same device back in the fall. Chromebooks that are not checked-in will be assessed a \$185 lost Chromebook fine per the 1:1 Chromebook Responsible Use Policy.

LOCKER CLEANOUT: On Monday, May 15, seniors will clean out their lockers during Advisory. Then on Monday, May 22, all other students will clean out their lockers during Advisory. Anything left in lockers after school on Friday, May 26, will be donated to charity.
