#### CHROMEBOOK REMINDERS:

- A Chromebook is not just a device, it is a school supply. This means that you should bring it with you to school everyday. Make sure you charge it every night so it has a full battery to start your school day. It's also a good idea to bring your charger cable with you in case you need to recharge throughout the day. Teachers should have a few extra outlets in their room in case you need some power.
- If you did not check out a Chromebook for the year, you may need to check out a loaner Chromebook every morning and return it at the end of the day if your teacher requests that you specifically have a Chromebook. To check out a loaner Chromebook, head to the Library before 1st hour begins. At the end of the day, you will need to return that loaner Chromebook back to the library.
- If you have issues with your Chromebook or if something on it breaks, please see Mr. Keena in the Library to figure out how to resolve the issue.
- Protect and Personalize your device! Now that you have checked out your Chromebook for the year, let's talk about taking care of your device. The device checked out to you is yours for the year, so make sure you treat it well. If you would like to add a layer of protection to your Chromebook, you can buy a protective sleeve, a hardshell case, or a laptop decal or skin. Please do not place any stickers on your device. Siblings eating in a school cafeteria will be charged the appropriate meal price.

Students must pick up the required components for a meal to qualify as a breakfast or lunch. One component must be a vegetable or a fruit. If the student does not pick up the required component(s) or picks up more than required, they will be charged individual prices.

#### Free and Reduced Meal Program

Free and Reduced Price Meal Applications must be completed every school year.

Applications can be submitted online or in paper form.

Income Guidelines for Free and Reduced are updated yearly.

Parents are responsible to pay for meals until the Free and Reduced application is processed. Applications will be processed within 10 business days.

Meal Benefit Status from the prior school year will carry over for the first 30 days of the next school year. If a new application is not received at the beginning of the school year, the student's meal status will change to paying at the end of the 30 days. Parents/guardian will be responsible for these meal charges.

#### **Payments**

MySchoolBucks is our online payment system for meal accounts. Parents can to set up an account and choose settings for automatic meal payments, low balance notifications, and other features. Parents can also view their child's meal and snack purchases. There is a \$2.50 fee charge when making an online payment.

Meal and snack payments can also be made at the school cafeteria in the form of cash or a check. Please note your student's name and lunch number on the check or envelope.

#### **Student Meal Accounts**

LPS Students will use the same lunch number from K-12th grade. Student lunch balances, will roll forward each school year. Student balances can be checked using MySchoolBucks or by contacting the school kitchen manager.

#### **Negative Charge Limits**

Elementary charge limit \$8.40 Middle School charge limit \$6.00. High School charge limit \$3.10. Snacks and Adult meals can not be charged.

In the event that a student has meal charges and exceeds the charge limit, the student will be offered an alternate meal.

Students with negative meal charges will be notified by phone message, until the account is at a positive balance.
