LABOR DAY - MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 4, 2017 - NO SCHOOL

STUDENT SCHEDULES: Friday, September 1, was the last day students could drop a course without penalty. Students will receive a withdraw/fail for any courses dropped after Friday. Withdraw/fail grades will be calculated in the student's GPA and remain on their transcript. Schedule changes will be made based on academic need and not as a matter of convenience. Students need to make an appointment to see their counselor with any schedule concerns.

STUDENT PARKING PERMITS: All cars in the Heritage student parking lots must have a current parking permit displayed on their passenger side windshield. In order to pick up your permit, you must pay the \$50 fee and have five things:

1. The completed Parking Permit Form (signed by your parent/guardian)
2. Your current student ID
3. Your driver's license
4. Proof of insurance
5. Vehicle registration

Once you have everything on the list, you may pick up your permit from the Activities Office. If you do not have a current parking permit displayed on your windshield, you will be ticketed and charged \$25. Students who do not have parking permits may park in free parking spaces - either in the designated spaces along Windermere Street or in the church parking lot across the street from the baseball field.

FOOTBALL TICKETS PRE-SALE: The Athletic Office will be pre-selling football tickets for the September 8 Heritage vs. Arapahoe football game next Tuesday through Thursday from 10:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. in front of the Main Office. This is a home game for Heritage, so any students who have purchased the Athletic Gate Pass need to make sure the word ATHLETICS is printed on the right edge of their student IDs. If you paid for the pass but it was not printed on your student ID, please see the bookkeeper ASAP so she can reprint your ID card. Students **MUST** show their student ID with the ATHLETICS wording at the gate to get in for free. Regular ticket prices are \$4 for students and \$6 for adults.

- Students must check in at the Attendance Office when they arrive to school late.
- If you receive an automated attendance call for your student that you feel is incorrect, please have your student go to the Attendance Office the following morning.
- Parents should notify the Attendance Office at least one week prior to pre-arranged absences of three or more days.
