UPCOMING ROADWAY MAINTENANCE ACTIVITIES IN THE VICINITY OF HERITAGE HIGH SCHOOL: The City of Littleton has engaged a contractor to apply a chip seal to Prince Street - from the top of W. Jackass Hill Road to Ridge Road. This work is currently scheduled to take place **during the week of September 17**. SIGN UP FOR THE FALL PSAT/NMSQT:

- When: The test is on the morning of Wednesday, October 10
- Who: Juniors (and sophomores if space available)
- **Cost**: \$16
- Why: Juniors seeking one more practice opportunity prior to the SAT next spring or seeking to enter the National Merit Scholarship Competition should take this test. Sophomores seeking an early exposure to this version of the PSAT test will benefit as well.
- Where to Sign Up: Register with payment in the Post Grad Center
- When to Sign Up: September 17 October 5
- Note: All sophomores will take the PSAT 10 as part of Colorado State Testing in April, and all freshmen will take the PSAT 9 in April.

SIGN UP FOR THE ARMED SERVICES VOCATIONAL APTITUDE BATTERY (ASVAB): Heritage and LPS use student ASVAB scores as a non-recruiting aptitude and career exploration assessment to assist students with identifying occupations that best suit their abilities. The ASVAB is currently one of the State and District adopted measures in both English and Math for demonstrating competency for graduation for current 10th grade students.

- When: The test is on the morning of Wednesday, October 10.
- Who: Open to 10th, 11th & 12th grade students
- Cost: No Cost
- Where to Sign Up: Post Grad Center
- When to Sign Up: September 10 October 1. All students MUST sign up by October 1st
- Note: If you choose to not take the PSAT/NMSQT, you can take the ASVAB. This test will not be used to promote or recruit for military purposes. If you choose to sign up for the ASVAB test, please know that transportation to Heritage will be your responsibility on that day if the test begins before the start of school. Start time is TBD it may be as early as 8:15 a.m.
