PSAT/ASVAB TEST DAY - OCTOBER 11, 2017: Preparation for the SAT begins with the PSAT/NMSQT test, and Heritage is committed to providing students with great opportunities to help them be successful both in the classroom and beyond high school. Providing opportunities for students to take various standardized tests and encouraging them to take advantage of the timely feedback these tests provide regarding college and career readiness is a valuable step in preparing students for career opportunities. The more exposure students get to college entrance testing, the more attainable and tangible their future aspirations become. Heritage will again offer a test day this year on Wednesday, October 11, and will include the following opportunities:

- **The PSAT/NMSQT Test from College Board** - Available to juniors; sophomores may take the PSAT/NMSQT if tests are available. Students' SAT and ACT test results may be the determining factor as to whether they are accepted into their top college choices. Score reports provided to students who take this SAT preparation test give students valuable feedback, allowing them to see which questions they answered incorrectly and which academic skills they should focus on. High test scores are an excellent means for saving money by earning valuable scholarships as well. The PSAT/NMSQT provides entry into the National Merit Scholarship Program and the National Hispanic Recognition Program as well as access to opportunities with other scholarship providers. - **Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB)** - Available to freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors. The ASVAB is currently one of the State and District adopted measures in both English and Math for demonstrating competency for graduation for current 9th grade students. Heritage and LPS use students' ASVAB scores as a non-recruiting aptitude and career exploration assessment to assist students with identifying occupations that best suit their abilities. This administration is not for military recruiting. If you are still figuring out your future or if you can't decide on a college major or which career to pursue, the ASVAB is for you. This test covers eight areas including science, word knowledge, mathematics, and mechanical comprehension. It assesses a student's ability to learn new skills and is a predictor of success in training and education programs. The ASVAB CEP provides career exploration and planning materials at no cost. Students explore occupations in line with their interests and skills, and also develop effective strategies to realize their career goals. The ASVAB includes a 90-item interest inventory based on John Holland's theory of career choice. Students can use OCCU-Find, the career exploration tool, which contains 400+ occupations sorted by interest codes so students can identify occupations that match their interests. Students need to stop by the Post Grad Office to register for both of these tests. The deadline to sign up for either the PSAT/NMSQT or ASVAB test is Friday, October 6. Please make checks payable to Heritage High School. On Wednesday, October 11, we will hold morning testing from 8:15 to 11:15 a.m. followed by an abbreviated afternoon class schedule **for all students**. First period will begin at 11:30 a.m. (The full schedule for the day is available on the [HHS website > Bell Schedules page](#).) Buses will **only** run at their regular Wednesday PLC Late Start time for all students whether they are testing or not. There will **not** be a later second run for buses. Non-test taking students requiring bus transportation should ride their normally scheduled bus to Heritage and report directly to the theatre at 8:20 a.m. for an alternate academic opportunity.

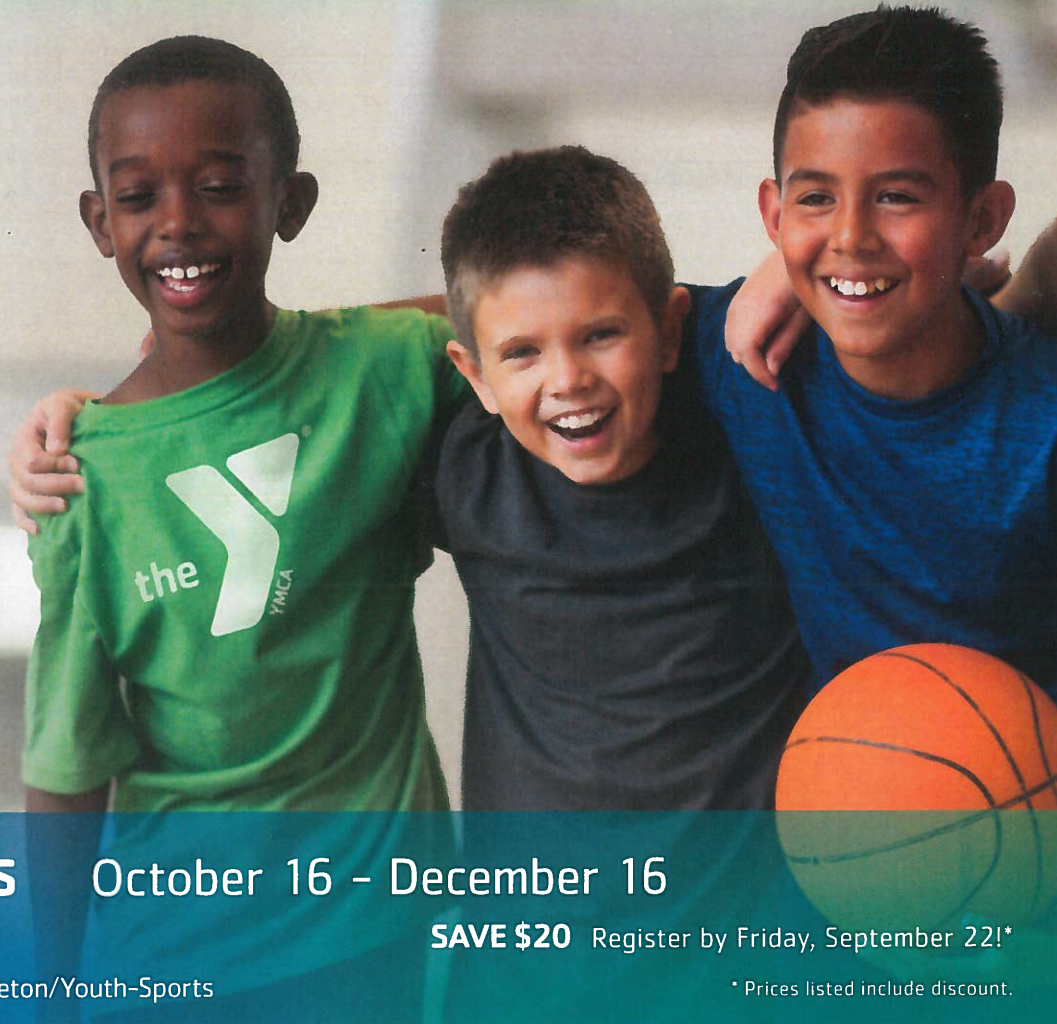
