**PARENT PICK UP REMINDERS:** In the interest of student safety and the need to allow buses to exit the parking lot on time, all parents are asked to pick up and drop off their students using the "Visitor Loop" in front of the building (off Gallup Street). Please do not use the Main Student Parking Lot for student drop off or pick up.

##### IF YOUR STUDENT NEEDS TO LEAVE SCHOOL DURING A CLASS FOR AN APPOINTMENT:

1. Phone the appointment information into the attendance office **the day before** the appointment at 303-734-6700.
  - a. Include the time your student needs to leave and the time you expect them to return to school.
  - b. A pass will be prepared for your student to pick up at the attendance window first thing in the morning. Your student needs to give the pass to the appropriate teacher before the class begins so he/she can leave class at the specified time.
  - c. If the student does not pick up their pass, they will not be able to leave class.
2. Upon returning to school, your student must check in at the attendance window, even if it is an off hour or passing period. Failure to do so may result in an unexcused absence.
3. If a message is left on the recorder the day of the appointment, it may not be retrieved until after your student needs to leave. It is important to call the live attendance line at 303-347-7630 ASAP if you have to call the day of an appointment in order to release a student during class.

Please note: The attendance office does not have someone available to run passes to classrooms, so if you arrive at school to pick up your student without prior notice you may not be able to get your student released in time to make your appointment. Thank you for your cooperation!
