- **The HHS Food Drive** runs all week. Donations can be dropped off in your Advisory classes, and the grade level with the largest donation contribution will win spirit points for the Homecoming assembly! [Click here](#) for a list of the most needed items.
- On Monday, October 2, **Powder Puff** takes place at the LPS Stadium at 5:30 p.m. Entrance to the game is \$3. (Your activity pass does not work.)
- On Tuesday, October 3, **Girls' Volleyball** takes on Mountain Vista. The game begins at 6:00 p.m. in the HHS Main Gym.
- On Wednesday, October 4, Heritage will have its **Fourth Annual Homecoming Carnival** on the school's athletic fields from 4:30-6:30 p.m. Tickets are \$1 each, or buy five tickets and get one free. Concessions and the Kona Ice Truck will also be there. The first 200 people to buy tickets receive a FREE gift. The **Bonfire** will begin immediately following (approximately 7:00 p.m).
- On Thursday, October 5, **football** plays at the LPS Stadium. The game begins at 6:00 p.m. and the **Homecoming Spirit Awards** will be announced during half-time.
- On Friday, October 6, the **Homecoming Pep Assembly** will take place in the Main Gym.
- Also on Friday, come to the **Homecoming Dance** from 7:30-10:30 p.m. OUTSIDE of the Student Center.
 - **Dance Guest Forms** are due by **Tuesday, October 3**. Forms are located on the [Homecoming webpage](#).

- **Tickets** will go on sale outside of the Senior Pit on Monday, October 2, and will be sold throughout the week during Periods 3-6. Everyone must have a current School ID to attend - NO exceptions. You can also buy the **Homecoming t-shirt** during those times.
 - Tickets (for students and guests) are \$30 and include the t-shirt (t-shirt is first come, first served). SENIORS ONLY - tickets are \$25 and include the t-shirt..
 - If you bring in five non-perishable food items, you can receive a \$5 DISCOUNT (one per ticket - not applicable on t-shirts).
 - Tickets are \$30 at the door (NO DISCOUNT - No canned food accepted at the door.)
 - There is a \$5 replacement fee for all lost or forgotten tickets. T-shirt also sold separately for \$10 (first come, first served).
 - NO REFUNDS will be given on any Homecoming items for any reason.

PSAT/ASVAB TEST DAY: Heritage will again offer a test day this year on Wednesday, October 11, and will offer students the following opportunities:

- **The PSAT/NMSQT Test from College Board** - Available to juniors; sophomores may take the PSAT/NMSQT if tests are available. Score reports provided to students who take this SAT preparation test give students valuable feedback, allowing them to see which questions they answered incorrectly and which academic skills they should focus on. The PSAT/NMSQT provides entry into the National Merit Scholarship Program and the National Hispanic Recognition Program as well as access to opportunities with other scholarship providers. - **Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB)** - Available to sophomores, juniors and seniors. The ASVAB is currently one of the State and District adopted measures in both English and Math for demonstrating competency for graduation for current 9th grade students. Heritage and LPS use students' ASVAB scores as a non-recruiting aptitude and career exploration assessment to assist students with identifying occupations that best suit their abilities. This administration is not for military recruiting. It assesses a student's ability to learn new skills and is a predictor of success in training and education programs. The ASVAB CEP provides career exploration and planning materials at no cost. Students explore occupations in line with their interests and skills, and also develop effective strategies to realize their career goals. The deadline to sign up for either the PSAT/NMSQT or ASVAB test is Friday, October 6. Students need to stop by the Post Grad Office to register for both of these tests. On Wednesday, October 11, we will hold morning testing from 8:15 to 11:15 a.m. followed by an abbreviated afternoon class schedule for all students. First period will begin at 11:30 a.m. Buses will **only** run at their regular Wednesday PLC Late Start time for all students whether they are testing or not. There will **not** be a second run for buses. Non-test taking students requiring bus transportation should ride their normally scheduled bus to Heritage and report directly to the theatre at 8:20 a.m. for an alternate academic opportunity.
