**ANNUAL FAMILY CHECK-IN PROCESS:** Please click this link to view important [2016-2017 Annual Family Check-In Information](#). All students must have a parent/guardian from their primary household complete the Check-In process by August 8th. This is an online process, and parents are encouraged to complete the process as soon as possible to avoid delays at the beginning of the school year.

*Please note:*

- ❖ After completing step 1 (Infinite Campus portion), you need to return to the [Heritage website](#) to complete step 2 (PTO form) and step 3 (fee payment) of the Check-In Process.
- ❖ If you have any questions or need to sign up for the parent portal, please call the HHS Main Office at 303-347-7600.
  - Our office will be open July 18 through July 28 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Monday through Thursday.
  - Beginning August 1st, our office hours will be 7:30 to 11:30 a.m. and 12:30 to 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

**1:1 CHROMEBOOKS:** All students at Heritage High School will be able to checkout a Chromebook that stays with them throughout the school year for their use at school and at home. As part of the Annual Family Check-in process, you will need to read the **Student and Parent/Guardian: Responsible Use Agreement for At-Home Devices** and choose to either opt-in or opt-out your student to be able to take home his/her school-issued device.

**SPORTS PHYSICALS:** All athletes must have a current physical on file in the Athletic Office by August 15 (the first day of fall sports). Athletic physicals will be offered at Littleton High School on Saturday, August 6, from 8 to 11:30 a.m. Please enter through the Athletic Entrance on the east side of the building. The cost is \$25. **SCHOOL SUPPLIES:** School supply lists are not provided over the summer at the high school level. If teachers want students to have specific supplies or materials, they will inform students during the first week of school. A suggested supply to start the school year is a Chromebook cover as each student who opts in will be issued a Chromebook for the year.

**STUDENT SCHEDULES:** First semester schedules will be available on Infinite Campus on Friday, August 12. If corrections need to be made, an electronic correction form will also be available online at that time.

**SWIM WAIVER:** Heritage will offer a Swim Waiver test for **seniors only** on Thursday, August 18, from 8 to 10 a.m. Seniors who wish to take the Swim Waiver test on this date must register by emailing Mrs. Lori Lee at [LLee@lps.k12.co.us](mailto:LLee@lps.k12.co.us) by 2 p.m. on Wednesday, August 17. Registered participants should meet in the pool area dressed to swim by 8 a.m. on August 18. [Click on this link to view the LPS swim waiver requirements](#).
