**SPORTS PHYSICALS:** All athletes must have a current physical on file in the Athletic Office by August 14 (the first day of fall sports). Athletic physicals will be offered at Arapahoe High School on Saturday, August 5, from 8 to 11:30 a.m. Please enter through the Athletic Entrance on the west side of the building. The cost is \$25. No appointments are necessary.
