AN INVITATION TO SERVE AS A PARENT REPRESENTATIVE ON THE LOIS LENSKI ELEMENTARY SCHOOL BUILDING ADVISORY ACCOUNTABILITY COMMITTEE (LAC)

WHAT IS THE LAC?

The Colorado School Finance Act of 1988 establishes a school advisory accountability committee for every public school in Colorado. By November 1 of each year, the principal of each school, with the assistance and cooperation of the school staff must adopt ambitious goals and plans to improve graduation rates and student achievement. It is a yearly responsibility of the LAC to monitor and report the progress made toward meeting the established goals.

WHO IS ON THE LAC?

The committee includes the Principal, four staff members, the PTO President, three parents who have children attending the school, and one community resident who does not have children attending the school.

WHAT IS THE TIME COMMITMENT OF LAC MEMBERS?

There is a minimum of six meetings each year. Generally, it has turned out to be a monthly meeting which is held after school, 4:00 – 5:00 PM. The term of a parent representative is two years.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Every parent or guardian of a Lois Lenski school student is welcome to apply for membership. An application/nomination form is attached and must be returned to the school office.
