

A day in the life of your K-Plus kindergartener...

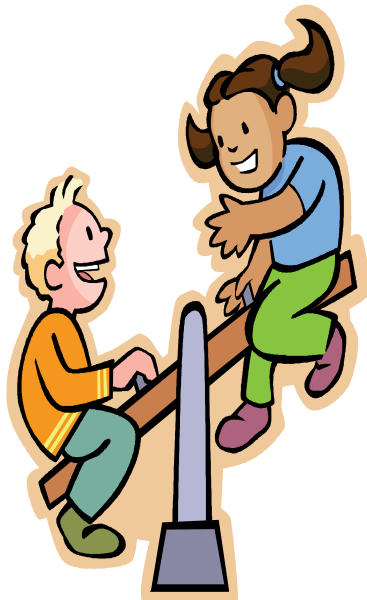
Your child will be picked up from his/her classroom and signed into K+ each day. We begin each afternoon of enrichment at 11:55 with lunch in the cafeteria. After lunch K+ kids enjoy the fresh air during recess time on the playground. Back in the classroom, the children will have the chance to participate in a variety of activities each day that might include story time, centers, whole and small group activities, art, writing, math, manipulatives, science, teambuilding, character development and dramatic play. Every child is given the opportunity to rest each afternoon, and an afternoon snack is provided. Parents are encouraged to pack an extra snack in child's lunch box or back pack, as these full days can work up quite a hunger!

K-Plus is the perfect choice for families who not only need full day care, but those who wish to further prepare their child for 1st grade. We hope that your family will join us in being part of the Highland family!

START DATES:

School begins for 1st-5th grades on Thursday, August 17th. This is an Early Dismissal afternoon, with school ending at 12:03 pm. Lunch is not served in the cafeteria on this day.

School begins for kindergarteners on Monday, August 21st; the K-Plus program will begin this day as well.

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What is K-Plus?

Kindergarten Plus Enrichment, or K-Plus, is a tuition based program designed to give half day kindergarten students a full day experience. Your child will enjoy extra time in the classroom to further develop social skills, as well as reinforce academic concepts that will assist in 1st grade preparation. The enrichment activities and lessons are a collaborative effort of the K-Plus instructors, kindergarten teachers & principal and are based on the LPS kindergarten curriculum. K-Plus gives many opportunities for additional exposure to:

- Socialization, creative expression, and problem solving through centers and imaginative play
- Letters, numbers and beginning math
- Science and social studies
- Using hands on activities to reinforce concepts and teamwork
- Group and individual reading time
- Simple cooking activities
- Gross motor activities through music & movement

Our staff of K-Plus instructors and paraprofessionals are required to fulfill 15 hours of early childhood training per year in such areas as child development, guidance strategies, health and nutrition, and arts and crafts, just to name a few.

Each staff member must also complete CPR, First Aid, and Universal Precautions training on a semi-annual basis.

You can rest assured that your child will be in good hands with our dedicated team!



K-Plus Tuition

School begins at 9:06 am, with the traditional half day kindergarten ending at 11:55. Your child will spend the morning with his or her kindergarten teacher. Children enrolled in K-Plus will stay with the K-Plus instructor from 11:55 until the school day ends.

Your tuition pays for the second half, or licensed, part of the day and is prorated for the nine months of school, September through May. All early dismissals, PLC late starts, In-Service days and closures are included when factoring the prorated amount, therefore, your tuition remains the same each month.

♦ **You may choose 2 to 5 days per week:**

2 days per week- \$143.50 per month

3 days per week- \$184.50 per month

4 days per week- \$225.50 per month

5 days per week - \$281.50 per month

Tuition is billed at the beginning of the month, and is due by the 5th of that month beginning in September. You may pay your monthly tuition with check or money order made out to "Highland K-Plus", or automatically by Visa, MasterCard or Discover. Once your registration is received, you will be sent a packet of information that needs to be returned for your child's enrollment in K-Plus to be complete. You will also receive a confirmation letter in August.

Because our program is licensed, your tuition helps provide:

- Supplies and materials for a variety of activities
- One healthy snack per day
- Support staff to maintain the required staff to student ratio of 1:15
