Minutes:

1. Welcome and review agenda/minutes.
2. Review/analyze Shannon’s work on areas of concern in proposed boundaries.
 - a. Look through potential solutions to isolated neighborhoods, and then try to put together “bundles” that could result in a new boundary map.
 - b. Lenski likely a school that would be easier to fill with OOD enrollment.
 - c. WEST SIDE Ideally, an asymmetrical K-8 on the west side.
 - d. We still want to avoid crossing Santa Fe for elementary boundaries (Centennial).
 - e. DOWNTOWN AREA
 - i. Note from Transportation staff: any tweaks we make to original proposal for East/Moody (expansion for East either to the south, west, or north) will involve adding a bus route.
 - f. Come up with scenarios that work to make good consolidations without having to change boundaries again.
 - i. Economic impacts of Covid-19 unknown at this point.
 - ii. Some families may really like online schooling, so we could potentially lose enrollment that way. Not sure whether LPS would pick up an online program (we have in the past) to keep that enrollment.
 - iii. Gives the Board of Education some options to work with moving forward.
 - g. Propose a scenario that has really nice, clean lines and balances numbers in the south/central portion.

- i. Shannon will work on this and we can send to committee.
- 3. Upcoming meetings:
 - a. Additional virtual meeting (Google Hangout) to discuss transportation implications of potential identified solutions.
 - i. Nicole will send Google Poll with times for April 16th and 17th for committee members to respond with availability.
