### **General Information:**

### **Primary Responsibilities:**

- Responsible for providing classroom support under the direct guidance of the classroom teacher in English Language Arts and/or Mathematics in grades 1-5. The teacher assistant pushes into classrooms throughout the day to help support instruction.
- Provide clear and timely communication of achievements and areas to improve to students and their homeroom teachers.
- Work with students, specialists, parents, and administrators to implement individual education plans and academic remediation processes.
- Assist teachers with grading assignments and entering grades in collaboration with the teachers.
- Do assigned duties, such as supervise student lunchroom, supervise recess, carpool duties, and/or clerical work for teachers.
