

Dear Arapahoe High School Students and Parents,

March 20, 2020

Well, like all of you, this certainly is not the way I anticipated our entry into Spring Break 2020! Thank you for your patience and grace as we all navigate this uncertain time of the COVID-19 pandemic together. You should have received an email this afternoon from our superintendent, Mr. Brian Ewert, regarding entry to LPS buildings for students-only on **Sunday, March 22, 2020, and Monday, March 23, 2020, from 10:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.** The purpose is to **pick up all personal and instructional items that have been left in school and PE lockers** should **Governor Polis call for a "shelter in place" in the next few days.** We also want students to have an opportunity to pick up **band instruments**, and they will also be able to stop by the cafeteria to **check out a Chromebook** if they do not already have one.

In an effort to limit the number of students in the building at the same time, please adhere to the **following schedule and access points** as best as possible. We understand and will be flexible with those of you who cannot meet these exact breakdowns. If you need to **pick up meds from the health office**, they will ONLY be available on Monday so you should come then. The schedule is otherwise **split by last-name alpha** rather than by grade level to **spread students out across the building** and to better **accommodate families.** Parents and siblings who are not Arapahoe students are asked to wait in the car.
