**ANNUAL FAMILY CHECK-IN PROCESS:** [Please click this link](#) to view important **2021-2022 Annual Family Check-In Information** on the Summer Information page of the Heritage website. All students must have their primary parent/guardian complete the Check-In process by Friday, August 6. This is an online process, and parents are encouraged to complete the process as soon as possible to avoid delays at the beginning of the school year. Please note: there are three steps to the HHS Annual Family Check-In:

- ❖ **Step 1:** Log on to your Parent Portal account on [Infinite Campus](#). Click on the Annual Family Check-In link on the left menu bar, and click on the 2021-22 registry.
- ❖ **Step 2:** Return to the [Heritage website](#) and complete fee payment. All seniors are required to pay the \$25 graduation fee. All other fees are optional.
- ❖ **Step 3:** Also on the [Heritage website](#) - please take a few minutes to submit the PTO Volunteer Form - the final step of the Check-In Process. There are many opportunities to help - everything from one-time to weekly, bi-weekly or monthly commitments.

#### **HHS WELCOMES NEW STUDENTS!**

- **Upperclass Students Orientation** - New 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students (including those who spent a year at TOPS) are invited to attend New Student Orientation on Wednesday, August 11, from 8:00 to 11:30 am. The HHS Ambassadors will give students a tour of the building, help them find classes and lockers, and answer questions before school starts on Thursday, August 12.
- **Freshman Orientation** - LINK invites all incoming 9th grade students to join them at Heritage from 12:00 to 4:00 pm on Wednesday, August 11, for Freshmen Orientation. Students will get a chance to tour the school and meet other incoming freshmen before school starts on Thursday, August 12.

**FALL SPORTS REGISTRATION:** If you have a student playing a Fall sport at Heritage, you need to register them on the Heritage Athletic registration site (<https://heritage-ar.rschooltoday.com>). This site can also be found if you click "Athletic Registration" across the top of the main Athletic page on the Heritage website ([www.heritageeagles.com](http://www.heritageeagles.com)). If you have never registered for a sport, you will first need to create an account, and once you receive a confirmation email that the account has been created you will login and register. If you are a returning parent/athlete, please log back into your account to register. If you are having troubles with this process please [click here for step-by-step instructions](#). Once you have completed the registration you/your athlete need to drop off a current physical to the Athletic Office or you may email it to [mpeters@lps.k12.co.us](mailto:mpeters@lps.k12.co.us) or fax it to 303-347-7639. Registration for Fall Sports will close at 11:59 pm on Monday, August 2. Before you/your athlete can participate on the first official day of fall sports - Monday, August 9 - you **must** be registered **and** have an updated physical on file with the Athletics Office.

**CLASS OF '22 SENIORS AND PARENTS:** Senior pictures are happening NOW! We recommend getting your senior pictures done before July 30th.
