- DAC: Elizabeth
 - Budget Report
 - Less money due to state funding
 - 7.2 billion for full-day kindergarten (per state)
 - 2.6 million for LPS - may be able to cover it
 - Legislation trying to get funding for full day kindergarten by 2021
 - The student count is going down overall, causing budget problems for everyone. Legislation is looking at how to “De-Taborize” Tabor to get more funds.
 - LPS is looking at our current boundaries and redrawing them
 - Transportation/Start Time panels
 - Elementary teachers/transportation is happy with the new start times, while parents do not like it as much.
 - Middle School has concerns with the start times, including parents being unhappy, fewer people coaching, and students walking home in the dark after activities.
 - High School panel will be at the next DAC meeting.

- PTO will be continuing with fundraising, especially important with budget cuts.

- Building: The architect for our building will be RTA out of Colorado Springs. Jacobs will be the project managers.
