Good Afternoon,

I wanted to remind you that Littleton Public School staff, including Charter schools and all employee groups can sign up for FREE testing for COVID-19. As was shared previously, Littleton Public Schools will be covering all costs for staff to have regular testing for COVID-19 through its partnership with COVIDCheck Colorado.

School-based staff and staff that interact with students on a regular basis can be tested every two weeks. All other district staff can be tested once a month. Testing sites are available at Cherry Creek High School, All City Stadium at South High School, North High School and Hinkley High School. The testing locations are open every weekday and hours are available on the sign-up link. Please sign up for a time that works best for you [by clicking on this link](#). The website will also be updated regularly to include other testing locations throughout the Littleton area as they become available. Please sign up for the location and time that works best for your schedule. Testing is quick and easy and results will be available within three days (24-48 hours after the lab receives test samples). You can sign up for a testing appointment at any time.

To sign up, the website will ask for your name, email, and phone number. This information will only be used for communication regarding your test. The laboratory is also required by law to ask for your age, sex, race, ethnicity, ZIP code, and county of residence. The security and privacy of this information is protected by law, just like at your doctor's office.

After you schedule your appointment, you will also be asked for your health insurance information. This is for the laboratory to request reimbursement. Once again, there will be no copay or cost to you for any testing related to COVID-19. If you do not have health insurance, you can still access testing at no cost.

On the day of your appointment, please arrive at your scheduled site as close to the time of your scheduled visit as possible. If your plans change and you need to arrive at a different time, please do so. Testing site staff and volunteers will work to accommodate you. Make sure to bring your access code and confirmation page with you. If you drive to the testing location, you can stay in your car and drive through the testing process. If you walk to the testing location, you will be directed to the appropriate area.
