WHAT IS DESTINATION IMAGINATION?

Destination Imagination (DI) is an educational experience that prepares learners for a rapidly evolving future. We do this through a project-based learning experience that gives students an outlet for their creativity while teaching them skills like problem-solving, self-confidence, project management, critical thinking, team work, and risk taking.



WHO PARTICIPATES IN DESTINATION IMAGINATION?

Each year more than 150,000 students across the world participate in the Destination Imagination Challenge Experience:

- Students Kindergarten through University
- Compete on teams of 2-7 students
- Solve one of seven challenges that are rooted in STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts, and math) concepts.
- Showcase team solutions at the South Metro tournament in the Spring

WHY SHOULD MY CHILD BE INVOLVED IN DESTINATION IMAGINATION?

Teams involved in Destination Imagination learn critical thinking, collaborative problem-solving, and project management skills. Students who have participated in DI say they believe it helped them:
