

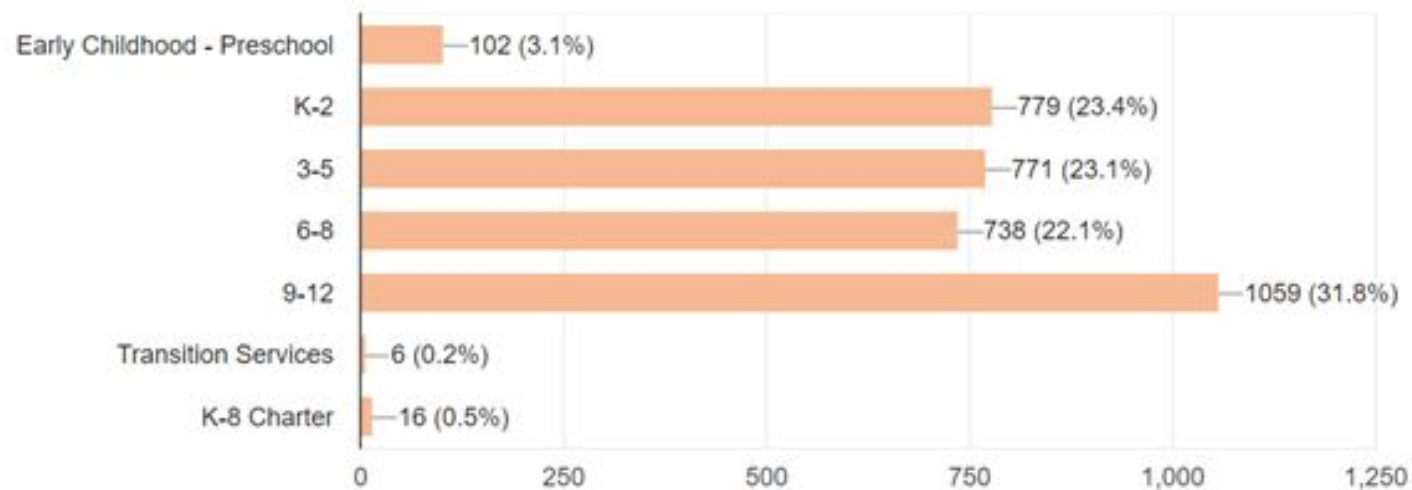
DISTANCE LEARNING PARENT SURVEY RESULTS

My child is a student at this grade level (please complete one survey per child)

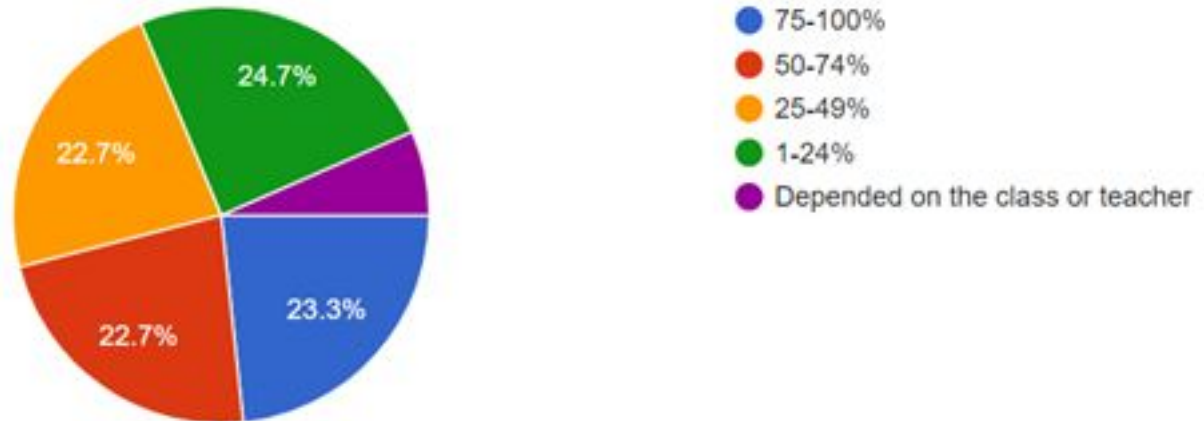

In your opinion, what percentage of time did your child stay meaningfully engaged in distance learning?

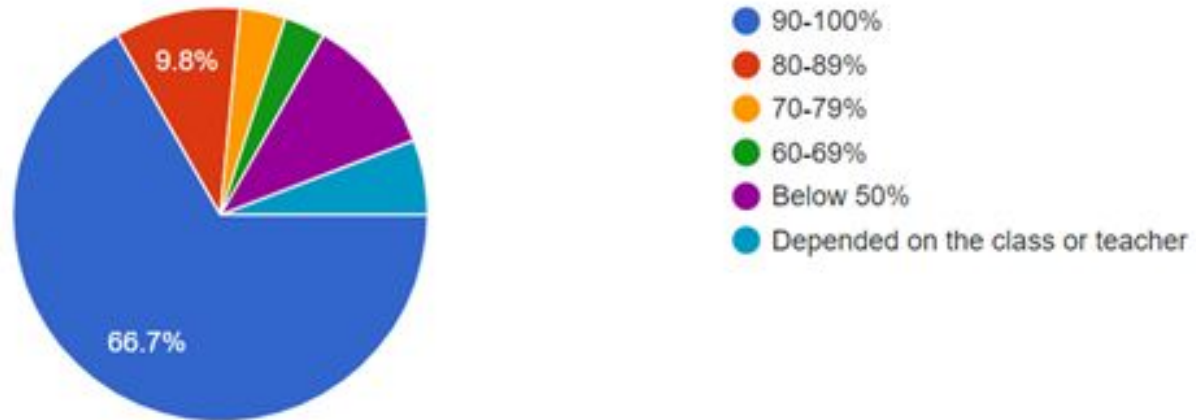

How was your child's attendance during synchronous activities (video conferencing) on average?

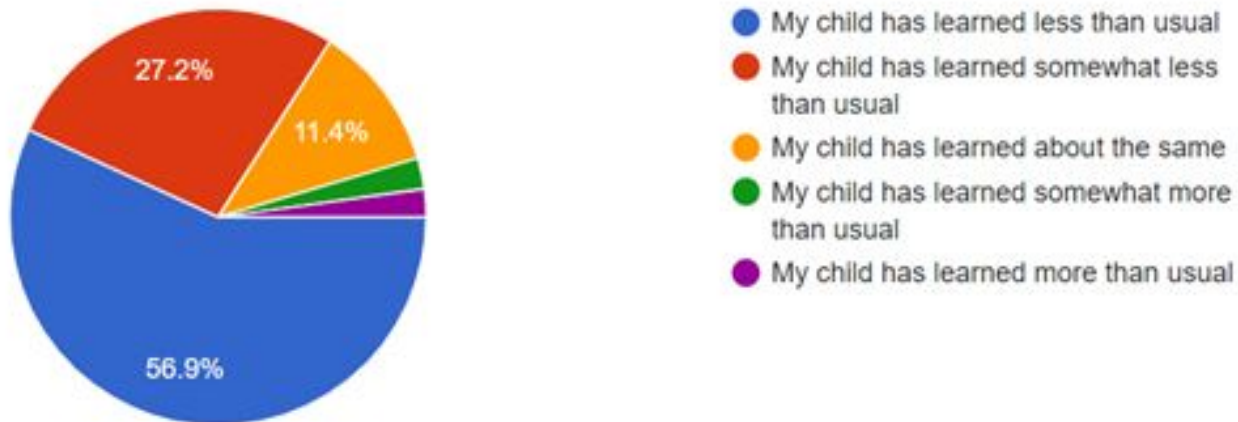

About 84% said your students had a compromised experience as compared with their normal schooling experience, and that your students learned less than they would have with in-person schooling. This experience was shared by parents with students at elementary, middle, and high school.

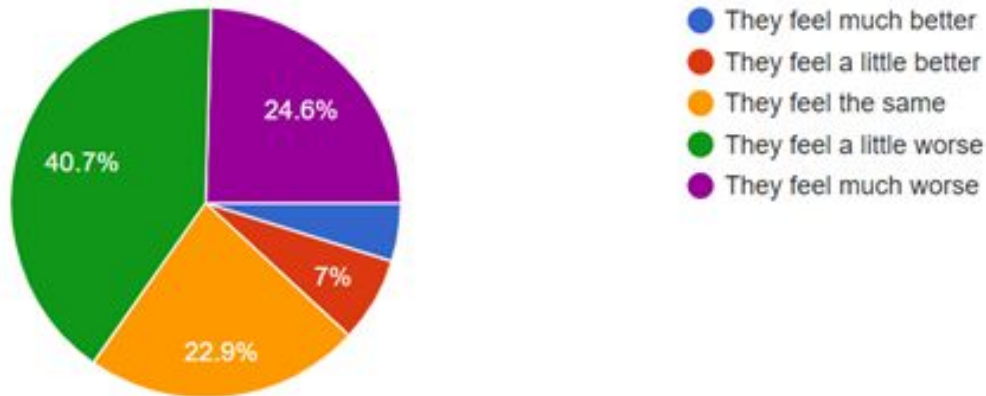

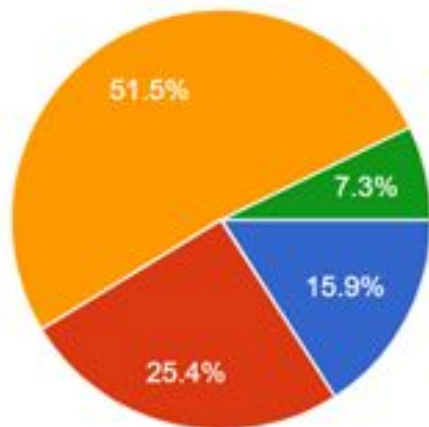


And during the survey window of May 28th to June 8th, here is what you told us regarding how you feel about reopening schools:
