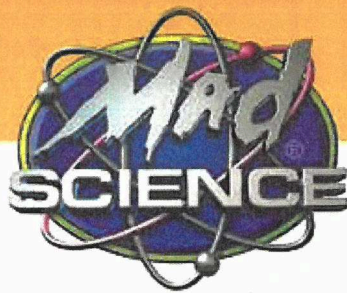

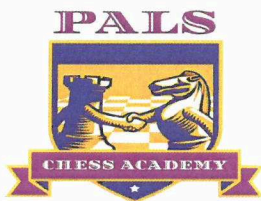

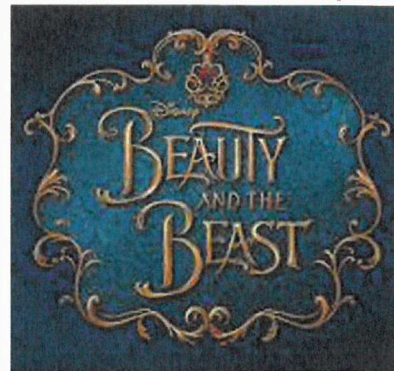

### ***Taekwondo classes at Wilder Elementary***

Family Tae Kwon Do Center Littleton, LLC will be offering TaeKwonDo and adaptive martial arts classes for students ages 6 and above of all learning and athletic abilities on Tuesdays from 2:45 PM to 3:45PM. Classes are taught by Certified Masters and instructors. Students will train, test, and receive their orange belt and certificate by course end. Sparring is not required at this level. Classes commence on Sept. 24, 2024 and will run through Nov. 19, 2024. There will be no class on 10/15/2024.

Tuition is \$225 per student, with an additional \$30 for a uniform if needed. All students must wear a Taekwondo uniform. For each student participating, parents need to complete the sign-up sheet and waiver and release form. Students in this program are also welcome to attend up to three regular "all belt" classes per week at our school in Littleton at no additional cost. Parents may also attend classes at the Littleton school at a cost of \$100/month, payable in advance, for the duration of the Wilder program.

Note: All children must be picked up at the front door after the class. We will stay with the students until a parent is present. If attending an after school childcare program, we will escort them to that location.

**Waiver and Release**

I, the undersigned, in consideration of being allowed to participate in activities of the Family Tae Kwon Do Center Littleton, LLC, a Colorado limited liability company (the "Center"), agree as follows:

1. Many of the Center's activities involve participation in martial arts which involve kicking, punching, throwing and otherwise physically attacking, or defending against, an opponent, with or without weapons. I ASSUME THE RISK OF BODILY INJURY TO ME AS A PARTICIPANT IN SUCH ACTIVITIES AND HEREBY WAIVE AND RELEASE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS OF ANY AND EVERY NATURE THAT I MAY HAVE NOW OR IN THE FUTURE AGAINST THE CENTER AND/OR ANY OF ITS MEMBERS, SUCCESSORS, PARTNERS, SUBSIDIARIES, DIVISIONS, MANAGERS, STUDENTS, EMPLOYEES AND DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVES WHICH ARISE AS RESULT OF MY PARTICIPATION IN CENTER ACTIVITIES OR AS A RESULT OF ACTS THAT OCCUR ON THE CENTER PREMISES OR AT ANY EVENT I ATTEND NOT ON THE CENTER PREMISES THAT IS SPONSORED BY OR UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE CENTER, provided, however that I do not assume the risk of bodily injury to me or waive any claim arising from intentional torts, intentional wrongful acts and/or criminal acts by the Center and/or any of its members, agents, successors, partners, subsidiaries, divisions, managers and employees.

2. I will not file, or cause to be filed, and waive, on behalf of myself and my heirs, conservators, administrators, custodians, and personal representatives, all right to file any administrative proceedings, charges, lawsuits, or other actions of any kind against the Center, its members, agents, successors, partners, subsidiaries, divisions, managers and employees with respect to any claim I have waived in Section 1 above.

3. The invalidity of any one or more of the words, phrases, sentences, clauses, sections or subsections contained in this Agreement shall not affect the enforceability of the remaining portions of this Agreement or any part hereof, all of which are conditioned on their being valid in law, and, in the event that any one or more of the words, phrases, sentences, clauses, sections or subsections contained in this Agreement shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect with respect to the remaining portions as if such invalid word or words, phrase or phrases, sentence or sentences, clause or clauses, section or sections, or subsection or subsections were removed from this Agreement.

4. This Waiver and Release shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Colorado.

5. THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE IS A LEGAL DOCUMENT. I warrant and represent that I have read and understand this Waiver and Release and that my signature below is my free and voluntary act. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned has executed this Waiver and Release on the date set forth below.

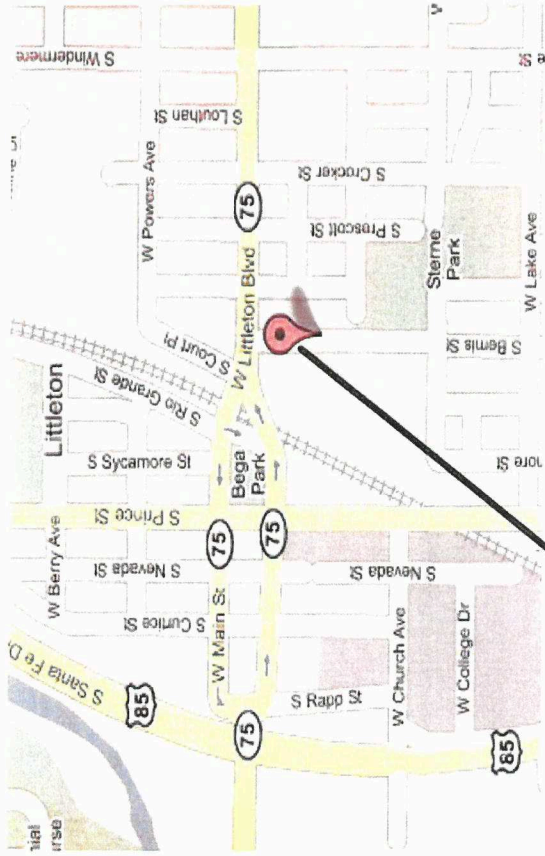
