Please Help Us Keep All Our Families Safe!

With our community full of little ones (with even littler siblings!), we want to ask for everyone's help to keep our school as safe as possible, and remember these requests for drop-off and pick-up:

- **PLEASE KEEP CHILDREN FROM CLIMBING** in, on, or around the front entry landscaping and flower beds.
- **PLEASE DON'T TEXT & DRIVE** in our parking lots. Parents have shared with the office their concerns of distracted drivers.
- **PLEASE KEEP YOUR CHILDREN WITH YOU DURING ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL – INCLUDING SIBLINGS.** Although the office staff greet and monitor the door when it is unlocked, the entryway can get to be a very busy place. Do not assume we are always available to stop children who are unaccompanied by an adult.
- **PLEASE REMIND ALL CHILDREN TO USE WALKING FEET IN SCHOOL.** Walking feet are safe feet.
- **PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE CHILDREN IN CARS DURING DROP-OFF OR PICK-UP.**
