



FREE SCHOOL MEALS!

FAQ



This semester, students and families have the opportunity to check out all the meal offerings that LPS Nutrition Services has to offer--for free! The US Department of Agriculture (USDA) is providing funding for Nutrition Services to provide free-of-charge meals to students through December 2020, or until funding runs out.

Who qualifies for free meals?

EVERYONE! All students eat for free for both breakfast and lunch regardless of their free and reduced-price meal eligibility. We encourage all students to participate in our meal program because the more meals we can provide the more we can support our students and department.

What about hybrid and TOPS students?

Hybrid students will pick up their remote-learning meals at the end of the school day on Monday or Tuesday each week. TOPS students will pick up their meals for the week on Monday or Friday at select locations. For information on times/dates please visit www.lpsnutrition.com.

What is included in a free meal?

Breakfast (please note breakfast service varies by location):

Entree, 100% fruit juice, fruit and milk

Lunch: Entree, fruit, vegetable and milk

What about adults and a la carte (snack purchases)?

Adult meals are \$4.25 and include an (entree, fruit, vegetable, milk). Students will be able to purchase extra entrees and snacks using their lunch accounts or cash.

Where does my student get free meals?

At their school during their normal lunch and breakfast times. TOPS students will pick up their meals on Mondays or Fridays at select locations.

How does my student get their free meal(s)?

Students will go through the lunch line like normal at their school. For TOPS students they can pick up at any TOPS location on Monday's or Friday's.

Do I still need to apply for free and reduced meals?

Yes! We recommend that families still apply for free and reduced meal benefits as this meal flexibility only lasts until December 2020 or until funding runs out. Student's eligibility helps schools in various ways, like securing federal funding for Title I programming and schools' eligibility for certain types of grants.
