

AS A FRESHMAN, WHAT FEES CAN I EXPECT AT ARAPAHOE?

Fees invoiced through Infinite Campus

Student ID Fee - \$5: The ID fee is paid before or at schedule pickup. If a student loses their ID it is \$5 to print a new one.

Class Fees – Vary: They will be placed on student accounts two weeks AFTER the semester begins. They are due October 15 (1st Semester fees) and February 15 (2nd Semester fees). Class fees are listed in the Pathfinder and are generally for workbooks or classes that use consumables (Art, Tech, Foods, Science Labs, etc.)

District Athletic Fee - \$135: There is a district athletic fee for all sports except Boys Lacrosse (which is a club sports.) It is due two weeks after the first competition of each season. It is assessed for each sport up to two per student (\$270) or three per family (\$405).

District Activity Fee - \$25: There is an activity fee for Choir, Band, Cheerleading, Toms, Color Guard and being in a Drama production. It is assessed one time for the entire year and is due October 15th or before dress rehearsal for Drama students.

Athletic Booster Club Fees: Vary by sport and are **paid directly to the booster club**. These are often collected before the district athletic fee is assessed. **They DO NOT include the district athletic fee.**

Fines:

- Late **library books** will incur a 25 cent per day fee up to \$5. Replacement costs vary for lost books.
- **Classroom books** do not have a late fee, but if they are lost there is a replacement fee that varies per book (\$7 - \$30 for paperbacks, \$65-\$140 for textbooks.)
- **Computers** – a lost or destroyed computer fee is \$150. Damaged computer fees vary based on the extent of the damage, up to \$150. Computers may be checked out from the library for one day. Late fees for computers and power cords are \$1.00 per day.
- Teachers may submit fines for other items, such as broken lab equipment, missing sports equipment, etc. Costs vary. To contest a fee, students must talk to the teacher/coach who assigns the fee.

Other Fees

Club Fees: Vary by club. There is usually a membership fee. There may be additional fees for competitions or club merchandise. Fees are generally discussed in the first meeting of the year. These may be posted to Infinite Campus or paid directly to the club sponsors.

Yearbook - \$67: The deadline to order a yearbook is generally December 1. Payment may be given to the bookkeeper with the Fee Payment Form (available in the May Drumbeat newsletter); or pay online with a credit card at <http://littleton.revtrak.net> starting July 9.

Payment Options

In Person: Cash or check is accepted in the main office by the Bookkeeper. The Bookkeeper's hours are 8:00am to 4:00pm; closed 12:15 to 1:15 for lunch.
