

FRESHMAN REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

2019-2020

Please use pencil and print when filling out your registration card.

SECTION A: YEAR-LONG REQUIRED COURSES

The REQUIRED COURSES of ENGLISH, U.S. HISTORY, SCIENCE & LAB, and MATHEMATICS have been added for you. If you took an Honors Placement Test, you have been placed according to your test results. Honors placement is solely done by the appropriate department and the criteria are supplied by each department prior to the test.

Refer to the “Unique Required Course Offerings” sheet for additional options for year-long required courses. If you are electing to take a year-long required course that is different from the one you have been assigned, (e.g. English 9 Girls instead of regular English 9), please circle the appropriate course on your registration card and enter the corresponding course number for each semester. If you are electing NOT to take an honors course that you qualified for, please email the appropriate department contact, as listed on your assigned course sheet.

SECTION B: YEAR-LONG OPTIONAL COURSES

LINE 1

World Language is NOT required to graduate from AHS; however, we recommend you take a World Language if you are college-bound. If you earned “A,” “B,” or “C” grades in 8th grade Language Arts, you may take a first year World Language as a 9th grader.

- **ALL incoming 9th graders interested in taking Spanish should register for Spanish I. After you have taken the common assessment, either in your current Spanish class (for all LPS students) or on April 2 or April 10 at AHS (for non-LPS students), your placement will then be determined and your schedule will be appropriately adjusted.**
- **ALL incoming 9th graders interested in taking Chinese should register for Chinese I. After you have taken the common assessment, on April 2 at AHS (for ALL incoming students) your placement will then be determined and your schedule will be appropriately adjusted.**

You may choose to repeat the level you took in 8th grade even if you qualify for upper level placement. Please enter the course name and course number if you are choosing to take a World Language.

LINE 2

Band, Orchestra, or Choir is NOT required. **If you auditioned for an upper level band or choir class, you will be notified by the Band or Choir Department about your placement.** Auditions are not held for Orchestra. The only requirement is experience playing an instrument. Please enter the course name and number for the beginning level of Band, Choir, or Orchestra if you desire to take one of these classes.

LINE 3

If you are interested in taking Yearbook Journalism, Newsmagazine Journalism, or Digital Media Journalism, please contact Greg Anderson for an application and additional information at GAnderson@lps.k12.co.us. Applications and teacher recommendations are due on Monday, April 22, 2019. Please note that Yearbook Journalism and Newsmagazine Journalism are five credit hour classes and class is held Monday – Friday. Digital Media Journalism is a variable credit class -- students can earn 2-5 hours per semester. The class is held Monday through Friday, and students can customize how many days they take the class.

SECTION C: SEMESTER-LONG REQUIRED COURSES

You will automatically be placed into a Swimming class 1st or 2nd semester. **If you would like to take one of the single gender Swimming classes, please enter that on your registration card along with the corresponding course number.**

SECTIONS D AND E: SEMESTER-LONG ELECTIVE OPTIONS

Your elective choices will be used to create your schedule with the correct number of hours. Please select **seven** Monday/Wednesday/Friday elective courses (Section E on Registration Card) and **seven** Tuesday/Thursday elective courses (Section E on Registration Card) in order of preference. You will enter all of these course numbers in the computer during online registration. It is important to provide the computer plenty of choices in order to give yourself the best chance of being placed into open sections of courses you desire. **Please note:** we will try to honor your requests but due to balancing of classes, they are not always guaranteed. If you do not fill out your elective choices completely, both on the registration card and online, alternate electives will be selected for you.

ONLINE REGISTRATION

Before turning in your card, you must register online for your selected courses by going to the LPS Campus Portal Site: <https://campus.lps.k12.co.us/campus/portal/littleton.jsp>. Refer to the handout “Arapahoe High School Instructions for Online Course Requests 2019-20” to complete the online portion of your registration. The portal site will be open through Monday, April 29, 2019. Use the registration card as a guide when completing your online course requests.

2019-2020 Freshman Elective Courses

You must take a minimum of 26 total credit hours per semester. Your elective choices will be used to create your schedule with the correct number of hours. You must select **seven** Monday/Wednesday/ Friday elective courses (Section E on Registration Card) and **seven** Tuesday/Thursday elective courses (Section F on Registration Card) in order of preference. You will enter all of these course numbers in the computer during online registration. You want to make sure you give the computer plenty of choices to try to schedule you into open sections of courses you want.

Classes are designated by the amount of credits offered. The first page shows year-long elective courses and how many credits are offered for each course. Next, you will see courses that are offered for three credit hours. Finally, on the last page are courses that are offered for two credit hours. If you request a two or three credit elective course, the computer *may* schedule you into *either* semester (but not both) if there is space.
