

LPS Foundation Spotlight March 2024

Littleton Public Schools Foundation Awarded More Than \$340,000 in Grants

We are pleased to announce that the Littleton Public Schools Foundation recently received five grants that will benefit community members, students, and staff.

The City of Littleton provided three grants totaling \$223,300 to the LPS Foundation from Stadium District Funding related to the purchase of the Denver Broncos Football Club. The money will fund summer school and camps at the EPIC campus, a chess club at Littleton High School, and activities at the East Community Center, including afterschool programs, outdoor learning, child care, a community garden, mental health services, and more.

In addition, preschool students at The Village Early Childhood Center are the beneficiaries of a **\$10,000** grant from the National Wildlife Federation's <u>ECHO initiative</u>. The grant is for landscape design, which will bring a sensory garden and outdoor classroom to their school. The initiative also provides professional development for ECE staff on activating their outdoor spaces and engaging children in nature learning.

The final \$110,000 grant from an anonymous donor went toward the purchase of a second <u>Anatomage virtual dissection table</u> for the EPIC campus. The state-of-the-art technology provides our Health Sciences Pathway students with a broader understanding of their subject matter and gives them a competitive edge as they seek advanced education.

We are extremely fortunate to have community partners who value and prioritize student learning and growth. We'll share stories and pictures about how the grants serve our youth in future communications.

LPS Foundation Grant Brings Unique Storytelling Workshop to Littleton High School



We previously told you about an educator grant that brought highly sought-after graphic novels to Goddard Middle School. Now, we're highlighting a grant that gave art students at Littleton High School a chance to create their own graphic novels with help from an expert.

LHS Visual Art Teacher Melanie Rapp invited University of Colorado Denver Film Studies Professor Dr. Andrew Scahill to lead a workshop that explored the world of graphic novels, which are a unique form of storytelling using images and words. The students wrote and

illustrated their own graphic novels with the knowledge they gained. This experience gave young artists

valuable insight from an industry expert and showed them different paths they might take in the creative world. Ms. Rapp said that the students loved the experience and have requested more visiting artists and photographers.

La Fundación de las Escuelas Públicas de Littleton recibió más de \$340,000 en becas Nos complace anunciar que la Fundación de las Escuelas Públicas de Littleton recientemente recibió cinco becas que beneficiarán a miembros de la comunidad, estudiantes y personal.

La ciudad de Littleton otorgó tres becas con un total de \$223,300 a la Fundación de LPS de los fondos del distrito del estadio relacionados con la compra del Denver Broncos Football Club. El dinero financiará la escuela de verano y campamentos en el campus EPIC, un club de ajedrez en la Escuela Preparatoria Littleton, y actividades en el Centro Comunitario East, incluyendo programas para después de la escuela, aprendizaje al aire libre, cuidado de niños, un jardín comunitario, servicios de salud mental, y más.
