**EPIC CAMPUS SUMMER PROGRAMMING REGISTRATION:** The EPIC Campus is excited to host Summer Programming. This is an opportunity for LPS high school students to explore their interests in a fun, engaging environment in one of our pathways. These classes aren't your typical classes and are offered as an extension of learning, not remediation. As these classes are for enrichment, students will not earn credit toward graduation but could earn industry certifications. Most classes may have a materials fee. The [registration form](#) is live! We do expect classes to fill quickly as seats are limited. Registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis.

**SENIOR GOOGLE ACCOUNT DEACTIVATION INFORMATION:** LPS will suspend all senior LPS accounts (with the exception of ASCENT/TREP students) accounts on **July 1st, 2024**. After that date, graduated seniors will no longer be able to login or access those accounts. Seniors should prepare for their Google account deactivation by:

1. Disconnecting any services (Paypal, Venmo, Netflix) from their LPS accounts.
2. Update emails with work, schools, military to personal accounts or their new school accounts.
3. Download any files (resumes, college application essays) this spring that you would want after July 1st.

**CHROMEBOOK COLLECTION:** Students, please return your LPS Chromebook and charger as you complete all of your finals during the week of May 20th-May 23rd, 2024. The final due date for all students to return their LPS Chromebook and charger to the table in the Main Entrance is 3:00 pm on May 23rd, 2024. 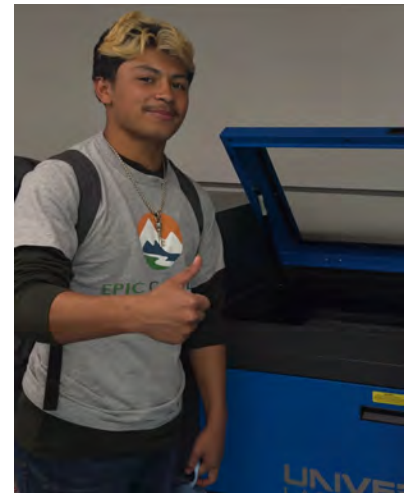
## LPS Foundation Spotlight June 2024

### LPS Foundation Grants Deliver Life (and Knife) Skills

Recent grants awarded to the Littleton Public Schools Foundation are affording students at the [Explorative Pathways for Innovate Careers \(EPIC\) campus](#) a variety of hands-on learning opportunities, and LPS Nutrition Services personnel got a culinary boost from nonprofit partner [Nourish Colorado](#).

**A \$100,000 grant for EPIC from the City of Centennial's Stadium District Funding will provide:**

- **Industry Certifications:** Each EPIC student is offered the opportunity to take industry certification exams. The grant will help pay for the exams, which range from \$50 to \$200.
- **Course Fees:** Because of the specialized nature of EPIC classes, every course has fees that are traditionally passed on to the student (\$25 - \$250 per semester). This grant will help offset those fees.
- **Uniforms:** Students are required to wear uniform shirts while on the EPIC campus to promote community and collaboration. This grant will give students a second shirt.
- **Paid Internships:** EPIC works with industry partners and schools to provide internships for students. Not all partners have funds to pay for interns. With this grant, 60 students will be able to participate in a paid internship.
- **Intergenerational Connectivity:** \$5,000 from the grant will seed a program for adult learning that partners seniors from our community with EPIC students.



**An additional \$5,000 grant from the Schramm Foundation will bring a Beekeeping class to the EPIC campus this summer.**

Instructor Mike Montgomery, the Natural Pathways Lead, has already procured two active beehives and is gathering supplies for this innovative offering, which will give students a firsthand experience in the art of overseeing an apiary.

**Within LPS Nutrition Services, a \$4,000 grant from a generous funder provided 70 employees with a 90-minute culinary skills session from the expert chefs at Nourish Colorado.** The training offered LPS food service leads with the knife skills needed to handle fresh, locally sourced ingredients and take that knowledge

back to their own school kitchens. One participant noted: *“This training is amazing because everybody in the kitchen comes from different backgrounds. And the trainers suggested some cool vegetable cooking/pickling ideas I hope we can implement in our kitchens every week to offer variety.”*

We'll share further updates about how these grants are benefiting students in the coming months. (And we might even ask for some honey from our newest, buzziest friends at EPIC!)

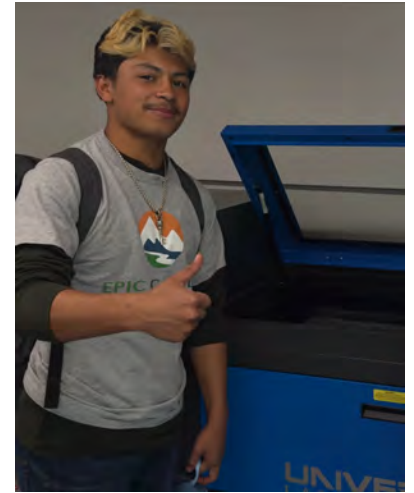

## Lo más Destacado de la Fundación de LPS Junio 2024

### Becas de la Fundación LPS para desarrollar habilidades cotidianas (y técnicas culinarias)

Las recientes subvenciones concedidas a la Fundación de las Escuelas Públicas de Littleton están ofreciendo a los estudiantes del [campus de Caminos Exploratorios para Carreras Innovadoras \(EPIC por sus siglas en inglés\)](#) una variedad de oportunidades de aprendizaje práctico, y el personal de los Servicios de Nutrición de LPS recibió un incentivo culinario del asociado sin fines de lucro [Nourish Colorado](#).



### Una subvención de 100.000 dólares para EPIC procedente de la Financiación del Distrito de Estadios de la ciudad de Centennial:

- **Certificaciones Industriales:** Cada estudiante de EPIC tiene la oportunidad de presentarse a los exámenes de certificación de la industria. La subvención ayudará a pagar los exámenes, que varían entre \$50 y \$200 dólares.
- **Cuotas del curso:** Debido a la naturaleza especializada de las clases de EPIC, cada curso tiene cuotas que tradicionalmente se pasan al estudiante (\$25 - \$250 por semestre). Esta subvención ayudará a compensar esas cuotas.
- **Uniformes:** Los estudiantes deben llevar camisetas de uniforme en el campus EPIC para fomentar la comunidad y la colaboración. Esta subvención proporcionará a los estudiantes una segunda camiseta.
- **Prácticas pagadas:** EPIC trabaja con socios industriales y escuelas para ofrecer prácticas a los estudiantes. No todos los socios disponen de fondos para pagar a los becarios. Con esta subvención, 60 estudiantes podrán participar en unas prácticas pagadas.
- **Conectividad intergeneracional:** 5.000 dólares de la subvención servirán para poner en marcha un programa de aprendizaje para adultos que asocie a personas mayores de nuestra comunidad con estudiantes de EPIC.



**Gracias a una subvención adicional de 5.000 dólares de la Fundación Schramm, este verano se impartirá un curso de apicultura en el campus de EPIC.** El instructor Mike Montgomery, director de Trayectorias Naturales, ya ha conseguido dos colmenas activas y está reuniendo suministros para esta innovadora oferta, que ofrecerá a los estudiantes una experiencia de primera mano en el arte de supervisar un colmenar.

**Dentro de los Servicios de Nutrición de LPS, una subvención de 4.000 dólares de un generoso financiador proporcionó a 70 empleados una sesión de habilidades culinarias de 90 minutos impartida por los expertos chefs de Nourish Colorado.** La formación ofreció a los dirigentes del servicio de alimentación de LPS las habilidades con el cuchillo necesarias para manejar ingredientes frescos y locales y llevar esos conocimientos a las cocinas de sus propias escuelas. Uno de los participantes señaló: *"Esta formación es increíble porque todo el mundo en la cocina viene de diferentes orígenes. Y los instructores sugirieron algunas ideas geniales para cocinar verduras y encurtidos que espero podamos poner en práctica en nuestras cocinas cada semana para ofrecer variedad"*.

En los próximos meses iremos informando de cómo se benefician los estudiantes de estas becas. (¡Y puede que incluso pidamos un poco de miel a nuestros nuevos y más zumbones amigos de EPIC!).

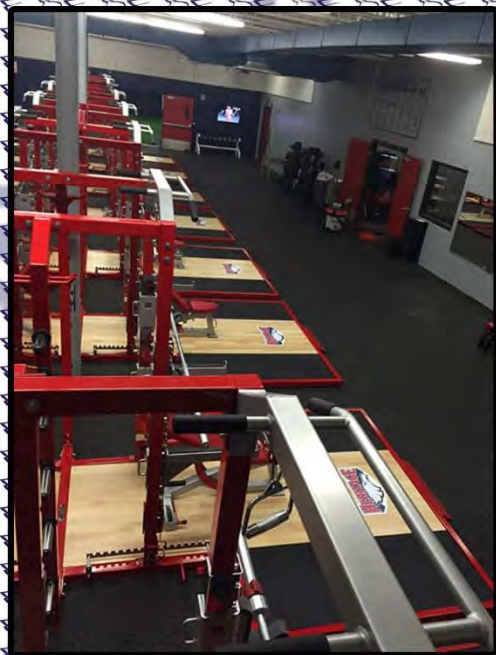
