Homecoming Spirit Week 2023: Friday, September 29th - Friday, October 6th. The theme is "*Hunger Games*." For the most up-to-date information, make sure to check out the [Homecoming webpage on the HHS website](#).

- **Battle of the Classes** will commence with the freshmen vs. sophomores and the juniors vs. seniors. The classes are divided into districts:
 - Seniors - District 12
 - Juniors - District 11
 - Sophomores - District 10
 - Freshmen - District 9

Each morning between 7:45 - 8:15 am (8:45-9:15 am on Wednesday), show up at the Main Entrance to get **counted to help your class win spirit points**. MAJOR points come from the dress-up days! Remember that the school dress-code and all school and district rules apply.

- Friday 9/29: "**It's In Our Heritage Red Shirts**" - wear your school shirt given out at the beginning of the year
- Monday 10/2: "**Alliance Day**" - your Advisory will all dress alike to beat the others in your grade (you will be counted in your Advisory, NOT before school)
- Tuesday 10/3: "**Panem Day**" - dress in your best USA / patriotic gear
- Wednesday 10/4: "**Tracker Jacker Day**" - dress up as a spy on the job
- Thursday 10/5: "**Capitol Day**" - dress up like anyone from the movie OR wear a wacky outfit
- Friday 10/6: **Wear Homecoming t-shirt or your class color**
 - Freshmen - Mustard Yellow
 - Sophomores - Maroon
 - Juniors - Gray Blue
 - Seniors - Black
- **Homecoming Shirts and Dance**
 - Freshmen, Sophomores, Juniors, and Guests - \$30 per ticket (comes with shirt, while supplies last). Cash or check only.
 - Seniors - \$25 (comes with shirt, while supplies last). Cash or check only.
 - If you want to just buy the Homecoming t-shirt it is \$10, but they are first come, first served with sizes and availability.
 - All grades are eligible for a **FOOD DONATION DISCOUNT**: Up to \$5 off the ticket price (1 can / pantry item = \$1 / 3 Ramen = \$1).

- Tickets will be sold outside of the Senior Pit during the week of the dance, Monday, October 2nd - Friday, October 6th. Specific times are as follows:
 - Monday-Friday: Before school and during BOTH lunches.
 - Thursday & Friday: Before school, both lunches, and all blocks.
 - They will also be available for purchase Friday night at the door, but no discount.
- **On Tuesday, October 3rd**, come out and support **Powder Puff Football**. The game begins at 6:30 pm at the LPS Stadium - freshmen vs. juniors and sophomores vs. seniors with finals after the first round. Admission is \$5, but remember that the HHS Athletics Pass does NOT work at this event. Concessions will be open, so come support your team, have dinner, AND win spirit points for your class!
- **On Wednesday, October 4th**, come to the **Homecoming Carnival** on the HHS Athletic Fields starting at 5:30 pm. There will be food and games for the whole family. Admission is \$10 to play the games or just come and hang out for free. Bring everyone to this fun event and stay for the **Ruff-n-Tuff Volleyball Game** starting at 7:00 pm in the HHS Main Gym. Admission for Ruff-n-Tuff is \$5. Remember the HHS Athletics Pass does NOT work at this event.
- **On Thursday, October 5th**, come out to LPS Stadium for the **Homecoming Football Game** as the Heritage Eagles take on Adams City at 6:00 pm. Students with an Athletics Pass will be admitted at no charge. Admission is \$5 for students, \$7 for adults. **Homecoming Spirit Awards** will be announced at halftime.
- **On Friday, October 6th**, the moment you all have been waiting for, the **Homecoming Pep Assembly** will take place from 9:37-11:07 am in the Main Gym! Be ready to battle in the obstacle course, "hungry, hungry hippos", ring of fire, and sing and dance during the dance off and riff off. Show all of your school spirit during class cheers and songs! Don't forget to wear your Homecoming class shirt or class color.
- **Also on Friday, October 6th**, the **Homecoming Dance** will take place on the Student Center Patio from 7:30-10:00 pm. There will be dancing and games for everyone. The dance is open to ALL HHS students, but you must have a **current** HHS Student ID. If you want to bring a guest from another school, you have to fill out and turn in the Guest Form to the Activities Office by Tuesday, October 3rd. You can find the Guest Form on the HHS website "School Forms" and "Homecoming" web pages. **Other important info:** Dates are not required-students can come on their own, with groups, or with a date.

Are you ready for Homecoming Ruff-n-Tuff Volleyball? Ruff-n-Tuff forms are now available in the Main Office. Each grade has 14 spots and they fill up fast. You will need to turn in your form and \$20 cash or check to the Main Office. Remember, Ruff-n-Tuff counts towards spirit points - seniors vs. sophomores and juniors vs. freshmen with the winners competing in the finals. You will play in front of a huge crowd in the HHS Main Gym! HURRY! SPOTS ARE LIMITED!
