2nd SEMESTER SCHEDULES: Students can see your spring Q3 and Q4 schedules online in IC beginning Monday, December 5th. If you wish to pursue a schedule adjustment request and you have a valid need regarding a graduation requirement, you will need to access this form: SCHEDULE ADJUSTMENT FORM. Schedule adjustment will run through the end of final exams on December 22nd. Keep in mind, you must make any requests for both Q3 and Q4 during this window, so look over both quarters for the spring.

SENIORS: Mid-year transcripts will be sent automatically to all Colleges/Universities that you have applied to by the Common App and sent an initial transcript. If you have other non-Common App Colleges/Universities that need a mid-year transcript sent in order to facilitate the admissions process, please complete the transcript request Google document, and write Mid-Year in the due date. There is no charge for the mid-year transcript, if an initial transcript has been sent and you have already paid the \$5 transcript fee. The mid-year transcripts will be sent out in January after mid-year grades are entered into IC.

SENIOR TRANSCRIPT REQUESTS: The Counseling Office will be closed over the winter holiday, from December 23rd through January 10th. This means that we will not be sending out any transcripts or letters of recommendations during this time. If you need a transcript or letter of recommendation sent to anyone please be sure to complete the transcript request google document by Monday, December 19th. Please check your application dates carefully so your documents are not late. Counselors will not be responding to emails during the holiday.

**ATTENTION FRESHMEN:** LINK will be hosting our annual Cramfest for all freshmen in the Student Center from 3:35pm to 5:15pm on Thursday, December 15th. Cramfest is an opportunity for all freshmen to receive help from their LINK Leaders in order to prepare for their first high school final exams. Snacks will be provided!


