OPEN ENROLLMENT RENEWAL: Current open enrolled students, both in-district and out-of-district, wanting to continue at Heritage High School next year (2019-2020 school year) must complete an "Intent to Renew" form. This form is due to the HHS Counseling Office by Thursday, January 31, and is available on the district website > Enrollment > Returning Open Enrollees > Intent to Renew 2019-2020. (The forms are available in both English and Spanish and are located on the left sidebar.) Families are encouraged to complete and submit the Intent to Renew form at the earliest possible date. FOR STUDENTS:

SECOND SEMESTER SCHEDULE CORRECTIONS: Please submit change requests for second semester using the Schedule Correction Form located on the "School Forms" page of the Heritage website by Friday, December 7. Counselors will adjust schedules by Friday, December 21. Please allow them time to work on this. In some cases they are waiting for classes to open up due to other students adjusting their schedules.

A schedule change will be allowed for legitimate academic reasons such as:

- Senior needs a class for graduation
- Student needs to meet minimum hour requirements
- Student has been placed in the wrong level of class
- Student fails to meet prerequisites of a class
- Student has been scheduled into two classes during the same period

LIBRARY NEWS: Did you know? If you check out a book from the library before you leave on break, it won't be due until NEXT YEAR! (January 8, 2019) Stop by the library and "check out" some of the newest titles in both YA fiction and nonfiction! Also, fee reminders from the library were handed out during Advisory on Friday, November 30. Fees of less than \$5 can be paid in the library. Any fees that are \$5 or more have been entered into your Infinite Campus account, and you must pay the bookkeeper and/or bring the overdue book or Chromebook to her in good condition to get the replacement cost adjusted to a late fee. ATTENTION SENIORS:

- The Counseling Office will be closed over Winter Break from December 22 through January 7. This means that we will not be sending out any transcripts or letters of recommendations during this time. If you need a transcript or letter of recommendation sent to anyone, please be sure to complete a transcript request form and drop it off at the Counseling desk by Monday, December 10. Please check your application dates carefully so your documents are not late. Counselors will not be responding to emails during the holiday.
- Mid-year transcripts will be sent automatically to all Colleges/Universities that you have applied to by the Common App and sent an initial transcript. Please stop by the Counseling Office to fill out a transcript request form if you have other non-Common App Colleges/Universities that need a mid-year transcript sent in order to facilitate the admissions process. Note on the form that you would like your mid-year transcript sent. There is no charge for the mid-year transcript if an initial transcript has been sent and you have already paid the \$5 transcript fee.

BOYS SWIM AND DIVE NEWS: If you are interested in joining the 2018-2019 Boys Swim and Dive Team, we will have a kickoff meeting on Tuesday, January 15, at 6:30 pm in Room 3294. This will be an informational meeting for parents and prospective swimmers and divers. Swimmers and divers will register, pay booster fees and order their team suits and equipment. In addition to the meeting, all student athletes are required to have a current Athletic Physical Form on file in the Athletic Office. Forms can be found under Forms at www.heritageagles.com.
