

Hopkins Arrival/Dismissal Procedures

As a part of our efforts to ensure social distancing and provide a safe arrival and dismissal for our students, Hopkins has adopted the following procedures. Classroom teachers will be sending a video demonstrating these procedures the week before school starts. Please remember parents/guardians are not permitted in the school building at this time. If you need anything please contact us at 303-347-4550. Thank you for your cooperation and flexibility!

Arrival:

Each grade level will enter through their own door (see map below). Students will not be allowed to enter through a different door, even with siblings. Students will not be allowed on the playground before school.

All students will be given a temperature check at the door and complete a screener questionnaire in the classroom upon arriving at school. If students have a temperature of 100.4 or higher and are showing one or more specific symptoms from the health screener, they will be brought to the health office. If it is determined the student has COVID-like symptoms, parents/guardians will need to pick up immediately.

Students can enter the building between 7:45-8:00. Students will enter the building and go straight to their classrooms through their designated doors. Students arriving after the tardy bell (8:00am) will need to enter through the front door and come to the office for a tardy pass and health screener.

All students and parents must wear a mask when on school grounds. In order to limit the number of people on our school grounds, we are asking if you choose to walk your student to their designated door, please only have one guardian do so.

When waiting to enter through your designated door, please socially distance from other families. There will be markers on the concrete to help with this.

The upper and lower carpool loop will be open. Please remember these are kiss and go loops. Parents are not to get out of their car in the carpool loop. If you need to help your student out of the car, please park your car along the street.

Dismissal:

Each grade will exit through their own designated grade level door.

Students will exit in a staggered dismissal to allow for more social distancing in our hallways.

- High Hoppers/Bus Students dismissed at 2:36
- Grades 1, 2, 4 dismissed at 2:38
- Grades K, 3, 5 dismissed at 2:43

Please remember it is important that you arrive on time to pick up your student and promptly leave school grounds to limit the large gathering of people. Students will not be allowed on the playground after school to help our staff ensure that all students are picked up by a guardian.

The lower carpool lane will be open. If you do not see your child, please loop around again so we can keep our line moving.

All students and parents must wear a mask when on school grounds. In order to limit the number of people on our school grounds, we are asking if you choose to meet your student at their designated door, please only have one guardian do so.

Siblings will not be allowed to walk through the building to pick up siblings. Please have siblings determine a meeting point outside before the start of the school year.

Grade Level Doors for arrival and dismissal:

- Kindergarten - Main Doors
- First Grade - Front of School South Entrance
- Second Grade - Upper Parking Lot Door
- Third Grade - High Hoppers Entrance
- Fourth Grade - Lower Playground doors
- Fifth Grade - Cafeteria Doors
