Access to School Meals

Nutrition Services will provide "grab and go" meals from March 16 - 20 at East and Field elementary schools. Anyone under the age of 18 may take a FREE lunch and a breakfast for the next day. It does not matter if you are an LPS student, the only requirement is that the child(ren) is present (being in the vehicle is acceptable). Meal pick up is available from 10:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the student drop off lane at Field Elementary and in the bus lane on the West side of East Elementary.

Instruction During the Current District Closure (March 16 - 29, 2020)

During the week of closure prior to spring break, LPS will not be able to provide formal teaching or special services. LPS is unable to replace core instruction and special services with online learning and services due to issues of capacity, equity and access.

LPS is providing level and content area-specific resources for students to access while school is closed. These resources are not intended to take the place of regular classroom instruction or special services, but will supplement student learning at home. No assignments will be required or graded. These activities are meant to provide optional, supplementary opportunities for student learning while they are absent from school.
