

# 8 Things You Can Count on ... Secondary Remote Learning



1. Students follow the bell schedule that is a **full day** of instruction

2. **Every class is LIVE half of their instructional time** each day, **or more**.

ex: 90min class = 45min minimum LIVE whole group instruction

50min class = 25min minimum LIVE whole group instruction

3. **Teachers are** synchronously **available on Google Meet for the entire period** even if students are working asynchronously

4. Remaining class time can include synchronous **small group** activities, **individual support**, etc.

5. Teachers have weekly **office hours** for student support

6. Class **Brain Breaks** during class

7. **Weekly Monday Communication** for flexibility of students' and families' schedules. Educators share the plan for the week: that includes assignments/assessments and due dates, to students and families.



8. Students use **Google Classroom** for assignments and **Google Meet** for LIVE synchronous classes.

# 8 Things You Can Count on ... Elementary Remote Learning



1. School start: 8:00 am | Wednesday start 9:00 am
2. **Common lunch** for all students at your school
3. **Brain breaks** and **recess** to reduce screen time



4. **Live learning** for every child, everyday, in core content areas
5. **Asynchronous learning** for every child, everyday, in core content areas
6. **Specials** everyday (art, music, or PE)



7. **Support services** will continue according to your child's plan (IEP, ALP, 504)



8. All learning is in **Google Classroom** and on **Google Meet**
