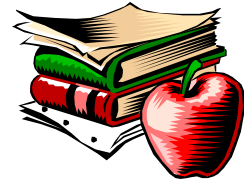


# EUCLID MIDDLE SCHOOL SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2019-2020



The Student Assignment Notebook, the *Student Agenda*, is required for all students. It will be available for purchase during Schedule Pick-Up in August. The Agenda is an organizational tool for students. Each day students are asked to record their homework assignments. In addition, school policies, a school calendar, and reference information is included. The Agenda is colorful and student-centered to encourage effective work habits.

## **SIXTH GRADE**

### **For Personal Use**

- 2 sets of tab dividers (if you choose to bring a binder)
- 1 box colored pencils
- 1 box thin markers
- 1 4-function calculator
