Dear LPS parents and guardians,

As part of our ongoing efforts to promote a safe and healthy culture at all of our schools, Littleton Public Schools will be implementing the Comprehensive School Climate Inventory (CSCI) during the month of October.

The CSCI survey is a brief 15-20 minute anonymous survey of students (grades 3-12), all parents, and all school-based staff to gather perceptions about the school environment. This includes questions about safety, relationships, engagement, support for learning, etc. We believe that gathering feedback about school climate will help guide our efforts to provide supportive learning environments for all students.

The CSCI survey is administered electronically and the results are completely anonymous (no names are recorded and no identifying information is attached to specific responses). Students will be provided time during the school day to complete the survey. Parents will have an opportunity to complete the survey via a web link sent by your child's school. If you have children at multiple schools, you can choose to complete a survey for each school or choose the school where you would most like to share your voice. After the survey is administered, the data will be compiled and shared with each school community.
