TOPS is a temporary program, with likely a smaller student count and therefore a smaller staff count than a comprehensive school. With those limitations, TOPS is not able to offer the full range of courses that could be offered in a comprehensive, brick and mortar school. Likewise, not all classes lend themselves to online learning, especially in the areas of performing arts. High school students who are currently on pace will remain on pace for on-time graduation with their high school of enrollment.
