





Q.1: I am confident that students and staff at our school can have honest conversations with each other about race, ethnicities or cultures.





Q.2: I encourage students to learn about people from different races, ethnicities, or cultures.









Q.1: Students know how they are expected to act in the school.







Q.3: Rules for student behavior are enforced in a consistent manner.





















































Q.1: I am confident in my ability to form relationships with all of my students.


















Q.3: Do you identify as Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender or Questioning?






Q.5: Race/Ethnicity
