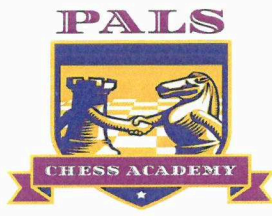
Our [Readiness Policy](#) does encourage all students to have at least one club and a putter at home to practice with if possible.

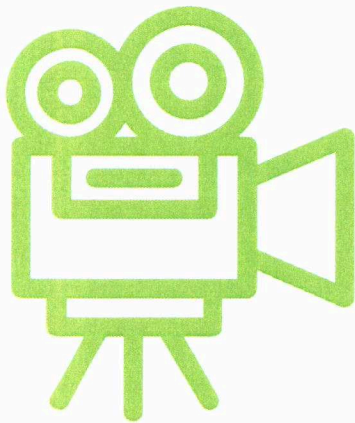

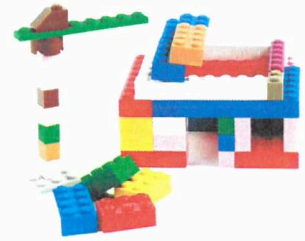
